STEP 1 RATES
(Effective for 24 months)

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within the entire territory served

AVAILABILITY

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial water service

(I) **RATES**

First	3,000	gallons used per month	\$6.69 per 1,000 gallons
Next	3,000	gallons used per month	\$5.80 per 1,000 gallons
Next	4,000	gallons used per month	\$5.21 per 1,000 gallons
Next	10,000	gallons used per month	\$4.45 per 1,000 gallons
All over	20,000	gallons used per month	\$3.04 per 1,000 gallons

(I) **MINIMUM CHARGE**

No minimum bill will be rendered for less than the following schedule:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 20.07 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 30.11 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 50.18 per month
1 - 1/2 inch meter	\$ 73.25 per month
2 inch meter	\$100.35 per month
3 inch meter	\$160.55 per month

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all current usage billings not paid within twenty (20) days, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected once for each bill where it is appropriate.

STEP 1 RATES (Continued)

TAP FEE

The following charge is to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of \$350.00 will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

RECONNECTION

\$20.00

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violation of rules, non-payment of bills or fraudulent use of water.

(C) **RETURNED CHECK CHARGE**

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the District up to a maximum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by their bank due to insufficient funds.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

Not to exceed two-twelfths ($2/12$) of the average usage of the applicant's specific customer class, or fifty dollars, whichever is greater. This fee may be changed by applicable statutory provisions.

(I) **LEAK ADJUSTMENT**

\$1.60 per 1,000 gallons of water is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

All over	20,000	gallons used per month	\$2.89 per 1,000 gallons

(D) **MINIMUM CHARGE**

No minimum bill will be rendered for less than the following schedule:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 19.11 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 28.67 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 47.78 per month
1 - 1/2 inch meter	\$ 69.75 per month
2 inch meter	\$ 95.55 per month
3 inch meter	\$152.88 per month

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all current usage billings not paid within twenty (20) days, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected once for each bill where it is appropriate.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

SECURITY DEPOSIT

Not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the average usage of the applicant's specific customer class, or fifty dollars, whichever is greater. This fee may be changed by applicable statutory provisions.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$1.60 per 1,000 gallons of water is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above the customer's historical average usage.
