

Bread of Life Series

August 1, 2021

John 6:24-35

What Bread are we hungering for? People use food for many things in addition to satiating true hunger: distraction, pleasure, medicine, and so on. As human beings, we crave food for a variety of reasons, whether good ones or not. This tells us something about our spiritual life! Sometimes we reach for a donut when we should be acknowledging that there is a deeper and more important issue that we are not addressing. Jesus is telling us, just as he told those in today's Gospel, that the food that will save us for eternal life is what we are really seeking. Do we listen to Jesus when he tells us that he is the answer to our hunger? Jesus said, "Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty" (John 6:35b). Come to Jesus and believe in him. Come to Jesus in the Eucharist because he is the Bread of Life that you are hungering for. Please continue to pray as we are in week two of a five week series on the Bread of Life discourse as a Diocese. Jesus, lead us all to a deeper understanding and experience of your saving love in the Eucharist.



