

AMS FIGURE 8 TRAILER RACE RULES

The objective of the Trailer Race is to survive 20 Laps with your Trailer still attached, while detaching your competitors trailer. If you lose your trailer.. Your done & must leave the track if possible. You will be scored accordingly. If you fail to leave the track upon loss of your trailer, you will be disqualified. If your axle becomes detached, you must exit the track. If your trailer becomes detached from tongue, you must exit the track. If you lose a tire or get a flat, you must exit the track. If you intentionally hit the Drivers door of a competitors tow vehicle, you will be disqualified immediately.

1. ALL CHAOS & DESTRUCTION GENERAL RULES & SAFETY RULES APPLY (ALL AIR BAGS REMOVED)
2. ALL DRIVERS MUST REMAIN IN VEHICLE WHEN A RED FLAG IS DISPLAYED UNTIL AMS SAFETY TEAM TELLS YOU IT IS SAFE TO EXIT OR RISK DISQUALIFICATION.
3. Acceptable Trailer Sizes
 - a. Minimum Trailer Size 5x8
 - b. Maximum Trailer Length 16ft
 - c. NO Yard Trailers Allowed
 - d. NO Pipe Trailers
4. Approved Trailers (NO Empty Trailers)
 - a. Pop-Ups (fully extended & fully gutted)
 - b. Boat Trailers (must have boat tied down)
 - c. Snowmobile Trailers (must have creative load)
5. NO Self-Destructing Trailers
 - a. Trailers destroyed only upon impact during Trailer Race
 - b. NO racing on blown tires
 - c. NO Driver Door Hits
 - d. ANY violation will result in DQ
6. Approved Tow Vehicles
 - a. Cars, Trucks, Vans (NO 4WD, AWD, or 1-Ton Tow Vehicles)
 - b. NO Anti-Freeze (will be checked)
7. Trailer must be attached to tow vehicle by free pivoting ball hitch.
 - a. One Safety Chain Allowed.
