ILLNESS POLICY

In the best interest of your child and of the other people in the child's class, it is best to keep your child home when he/she is ill. A child needs to be well to be able to participate in the program. Also, if a child comes to school when he/she is not well, he/she will be more vulnerable to infection.

A few simple rules to follow are:

1. A Child's temperature must be normal for 24 hours after a fever has broken before returning to school.
2. If a child is well enough to come to school, we will expect him/her to participate in all the classroom activities, including going outdoors with the class.
3. Often, a child may ask to come to school even though he/she is ill. Although your child may be disappointed, please keep him/her home.
4. If your child becomes ill at school, we will call you to pick him/her up. We will not call you unless your child needs to be at home.
5. Any child afflicted with an infectious disease, such as: strep throat, chicken pox, pink eye, etc., must be kept at home until he/she is free from the disease. Parents or Guardians must notify the school about any such infectious disease.
