PROGRAM MISSION

The objective of Environmental Learning Theatre is to connect audiences with messages about the role of humans in shaping environmental conditions and the role the natural environment plays in human health.

Using storytelling, Environmental Learning Theatre addresses a spectrum of environmental issues. Through connectedness and sharing, storytelling as art provides a powerful method to connect with audiences.

The importance of Environmental Learning Theatre lies within its power to shape early learning to impact attitudes and behaviors that support a healthy natural environment.




OVERVIEW: Each year, Environmental Learning Theatre increases its reach of more than 1200 Georgia K – 3 elementary school students with interactive educational performances.
