Code of Conduct

for

Players, Parents, Spectators and Team representatives

- 1. Conduct yourself with honor and dignity. Demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times. Your actions reflect on your team, community and SBSL.
- 2. Know the Laws of the Game (game rules) and always obey them
- 3. Accept the decisions of the officials. Officials are human and are bound to make mistakes. The field is big and there are players running around obstructing the officials view.
- 4. Believe in honesty of your opponents.
- 5. Never encourage, condone or participate in any activities that may intentionally injure players, officials, spectators or damage soccer facilities.
- 6. Respect your coach.
- 7. Come to the fields ready to practice or play
- 8. Let your kids play and the coaches coach. You are not a player or a coach on the team.
- 9. Support your team, coaches and representatives in positive manner.
- 10. Discuss concerns with your coach in private.
- 11. Do not speak negatively of an opposing player, opposing teams, coaches or officials.
- 12. Support SBSL in a positive manner.
- 13. As the parent or guardian you are responsible for the actions of any guest that may come to watch your child play.
- 14. If asked to leave the field by a referee or a board member will result in a minimum of a one game suspension.

## IN ADDITION

- 1. Service animals only with proper identification
- 2. No tobacco products, this includes electronic devices
- 3. No firearms
- Only handicapped parking behind the Knights of Columbus building with proper identification. Everyone else needs to park in front of the church. You can't park on the road to the cemetery
- 5. Absolutely no parking on the grass
- 6. No drones
