



Dear Winterail Dealer,

Enclosed is a dealer contract for next year's WINTERAIL to be held **Saturday AND Sunday, March 19 and 20, 2022** at Corvallis High School located at 1400 NW Buchanan Avenue, Corvallis, Oregon. This will be our 42nd year and we would like to thank the many dealers that have been regular supporters of the show. We sincerely hope to welcome you back.

We are excited to announce we are holding Winterail for 2 days: Saturday, March 19 is dedicated to our postponed 2020 show; Sunday, March 20 we will "catch up" with a 2021-22 show. Hours for the Collectables Sale are: Saturday, March 19 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.; Sunday, March 20 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

We will be following all COVID-19 protocols in place per guidelines of the Corvallis School District and the Oregon Department of Education. This may include providing proof of COVID-19 vaccination or proof of negative test. ANY UPDATED PROTOCOLS will be posted on our website www.winterail.com and Facebook page. We appreciate everyone's understanding.

TABLE COSTS – Dealers. All tables are 8 feet and come with 2 chairs. The cost is \$60 per set of 1 table and 2 chairs for Saturday, and an additional \$5 for Sunday. All dealers will be located indoors in the Corvallis High School Student Center. There is a provision for electricity in some locations; please note if you will need power on the contract. Please note that we have lifted the 2-table restriction on the contract; however, Winterail producers reserve the right to accommodate requests based on available space at the time the request for tables is received.

Non-Profits and Historical Groups. All such groups will be charged \$50 per set of 1 table and 2 chairs for Saturday, and an additional \$5 for Sunday.

If you participated in Winterail in 2019, you will be offered the same table location or as close as possible.

TABLE RESERVATIONS. Long-standing dealers will have until **Tuesday, November 30, 2021 to return their requests.** First-time and newer dealers will be awarded tables based on availability and postmark date. This should offset common problems such as postal misdirection of letters, vacations, etc. Please return your contract and check as soon as possible so that we can assign and confirm tables promptly. Long-standing dealers who fail to get their requests in by the deadline will also be assigned tables based on postmark date along with the newer dealers.

FRIDAY NIGHT SET-UP. Tables may be set up from 5 to 9 p.m. The building will be locked after 9 p.m. Only authorized Corvallis School District 509J personnel have access to the building. After midnight, a monitored alarm system is activated. It is recommended that any valuable items be removed from the building when you leave that night. Please note that the event coordinators, students, and Corvallis School District 509J employees will not be held responsible for any lost, damaged, or stolen items. Dealers may start setting up on Saturday morning from 7 to 9 a.m. Doors open to the general public at 9 a.m. *We will have no early admissions to the sale on Friday night; no exceptions.*

SPECIAL NOTE. School District policy does not allow any overnight camping on district property. No motor homes or campers are allowed overnight parking/camping at Corvallis High School. No smoking or vaping is allowed at any Corvallis School District 509J property. If you must smoke or vape, please go to the public sidewalks. Dogs are not allowed on district property unless they are service animals. No alcohol on the property. Dealers, Winterail staff, and attendees who violate these district policies will not be invited back.

WINTERAIL SHOWS. Entrance to the theatre shows is not included in your table fee. Winterail show ticket information will be mailed out in December. If you wish to purchase digital show tickets, you must do that once tickets are available for sale. Due to the costs of putting together the event, we cannot provide dealer discounts for Winterail tickets. Entrance to the Saturday evening show (after dinner break) will be available to dealers for \$20. See Vic Neves on the day of the show.

SALES TAX. Oregon does not charge state sales tax; no extraneous paperwork will be required.

DOOR PRIZES. Dealers wishing to donate door prizes for the raffle held during the slide shows must notify us in advance of the show in order to be properly credited. We encourage all dealers to participate; this provides you with free publicity to a captive audience of railfans.

SUMMARY OF TABLE RESERVATION INFORMATION.

Table set-up times are Friday night 5 to 9 p.m. and Saturday morning from 7 to 9 a.m. On Saturday morning, the public will be allowed entry at 9 a.m.; all dealers must be set up by that time. Every dealer agrees to remain set up until 4 p.m. and every dealer must vacate the Corvallis High School Student Center by 5 p.m. Failure to abide by this request risks a dealer not invited back next year.

Table coverings are encouraged and must be provided by the dealer.

Dealers agree to release show promoters and Corvallis School District 509J and its employees, students, and volunteers from all liability for injury, theft, damage or breakage that may occur to persons or property.

Any dealer caught selling fake or reproduction items that are not clearly identified as such will be asked to leave the show without refund. The signing of a dealer contract signifies acceptance of this policy.

Dealers are encouraged to have all merchandise priced for immediate sale.

You are encouraged to keep a receipt book and issue a receipt for all sales. Please note that Oregon does not have state sales tax.

Dealers agree not to fasten any material to fixtures or walls in any manner.

Dealers agree not to assign or sublet any part of a table without written consent of the show producers.

Corvallis School District 509J policies do not allow: Overnight camping on district property; smoking/vaping at any district property; dogs on district property except for service animals; or alcohol on district property.
