

## Types of Learning Options for OLOP Parish School of Religion 2020-2021:

- **Face-to-Face:** Traditional learning model. Students attend each Sunday for class 10:15am – 11:45am.
- **Blended:** Utilizing Google Classroom or "Flipped Classroom Platform" through My Catholic Faith Delivered. Students attend in person one/two times a month, other Sundays (work at own pace) virtually.

A new approach to improving parish religious education and engaging our children in the Faith.

### How it works

The flipped classroom inverts traditional teaching methods by delivering instruction online, outside of the class, and moving "homework" into the classroom.

**The Traditional Classroom**  
Lecture (in class) / Home Work (at home)

**The Flipped Classroom**  
Lecture Before Class (at home) / Classroom Activities (in class)

### The Benefits

1. Increases catechist time for coaching students on skills and application (less time spent lecturing in class)
2. Allows parents to be the primary educator of the Faith by providing a systematic program to use with children at home
3. Increases time for group engagement and class activities while giving catechists the ability to assist in areas of misunderstanding
4. Benefits students who miss class due to illness, weather, and other reasons
5. Uses engaging educational technology that speaks the language of youth and meets each family's spiritual needs

- **Full Virtual:** students/families utilize Google Classroom or "Flipped Classroom Platform" for lessons, assignments turned in via learning platforms, email, or paperwork turned in to teacher(s) each Sunday.
