<u>A Reminder about Financial contributions to</u> the Parish

You may or may not know but St Anne Westby, will be 160 years old on the 26th August. The Bishop formally opened the church on August 26th 1860 and on December 4th 1860 he consecrated the altar. The church was consecrated by Bishop Whiteside on November 8th 1900. The cemetery was approved for burials on April 18th 1864, the first burial recorded was that of Catherine Whiteside on May 24th 1868. Bishop Paul was due to come in September to celebrate but this has had to be postponed. Please add the church and the parishioners in your prayers. Long may we worship and congregate here for at least another 160 years.
