



2018 Car Number Information

THE BASICS

- It is required for each car racing in a Speedrome points division to register for a car number BEFORE participating in ANY on track activity. No Registration = No Racing.
- It is required for each driver racing in a prize money event at the Indianapolis Speedrome to have that years W-9 on file for payout purposes BEFORE participating in ANY on track activity. No W-9 = No Pay Check.
- The car must be present to register for a car number. Number registration is done only in the pit area at a Speedrome event such as open practice or a race event.
- A car number is a very important item. It is how people identify your car. A car number needs to be easily readable. Remember there are times when your car is going to be 100 yards away from fans while your car is in motion racing in traffic and you want them to identify your car. Many numbers look good in your garage but are not effective for identification on the race track. A basic rule is a light-colored car should have a dark-colored number and vice versa.
- Car numbers must appear on both doors and on the roof. Door and roof numbers shall be a minimum of 16" tall and 3" in line thickness. The roof number needs to be facing the passenger side of the car for scoring/fan purposes. Stocks, Thundercars, and Factory FWD's are required to utilize a 6" white car number in the upper corner of the front windshield on the passenger side of the car. Ineligible car number may be required to be fixed before the next event.
- Getting the registration process handled before the opening event is highly recommended. So many choose to wait for opening night or any race night to register thus waiting in line and missing most of their practice time.

AVAILABLE CAR NUMBERS

- Number are first-come, first serve.
- A number is only used once in each division. No letters. There are a few exceptions such as out-of-town owned cars or Legend cars in which the adding of a letter is an option. Letters can make fan identifiability tougher.
- Late Models will choose from numbers 1 thru 99 as well as 0, 00, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, and 09.
- Stocks will choose from numbers 1 thru 99 as well as 0, 00, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, and 09.
- Thundercars will choose from numbers 1 thru 199 as well as 0, 00, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, and 09.
- Factory FWD's will choose from numbers 1 thru 199 as well as 0, 00, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, and 09.
- Junior Faskarts will choose from numbers 1 thru 99 as well as 0, 00, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, and 09.
- Adult Faskarts will choose from numbers 1 thru 99 as well as 0, 00, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, and 09.
- Legends will use the number registered for while getting their INEX license but will still need a Speedrome registration.
- The Speedrome has final approval over the use of a car number.
