## Meet Entry Fee for Athletes: FIRST 700 PAID ENTRIES ONLY

Athlete fee is $\$ 25$. ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE. ALL ENTRY FEES MUST
BE PAID ONLINE at www.coacho.com. Entry will not be processed unless entry fee is paid by the deadline. All major credit cards accepted online.

Entry Process: All teams and unattached athletes must utilize the online entry process via CoachO.com. Immediately after registering online, you will receive a receipt from the website, which will produce a list of all athletes registered for the meet. This receipt should be used as your transcript of your meet entries. If your athletes do not appear on the confirmation, they are not registered for the meet.

## FIRST 700 PAID ENTRIES ONLY

Deadline Date: Registration will close on April 24, 2024 OR when 700 entries have paid, whichever is sooner. There will be no changes or additions to registration after April 24th.

Packet Pickup: Early packet pick up may or may not take place and will be announced the week of the meet through email. A team representative will be responsible for picking up the packets, and for bringing proof of payment. Packets can be picked up at the stadium on the day of the event starting at 7AM.

## Spectators:

- Cash Prize Raffle! All paid spectators will be given a raffle ticket. There will be three (3) winners of \$100 each announced after the 100 m dash event.

Coach Bands will be given 1 Per 10 athletes (Limit 5), Additional Coach bands will cost $\$ \mathbf{5}$ each. Coaches bands will allow access to the field and warm-up areas. Only Athletes and coaches are allowed on the field and the warm-up areas.

Implements: You must bring your own implements and relay batons to compete. There will not be any house implements or relay batons to share. However, all implements should be weighed in and approved.

Uniforms: If the uniform is of a two-piece design (top and bottom), the top must either be tucked into the waistband or cover the waistband when the athlete is standing erect. Relays must have matching tops and the same color bottoms.

Awards: In individual and relay events, medals will be presented for participants who finish 1st - 3rd place, athletes or coaches will come pick up their medals at the designated area. The person picking up the medal must print their name and sign for the medal.

Refreshments: There will be food trucks, and the Concession Stand will be open as well.

## Miscellaneous:

- ICE chests are allowed
- No glass or alcohol allowed in the facility
- If you have tents in the bleachers, they must be placed in the upper levels only.

Any athlete that does not check-in before their scheduled heat is run will be scratched from the event. All Field Events will follow schedule below. This is a rolling schedule. Listen to announcements for calls to your Field Event. Any athlete who does not check-in before their designated flight starts will be scratched from the event. Field Event athletes who have a conflict with a running event will be released by the Field Event Official - ONLY - at the appropriate time. Field Event athletes will have 10 minutes to report back to their Field Event after their running event and be ready to compete.
