## Meet Our Members

Yvonne David was born in Nairobi, Kenya, and raised there and in London, England. She remembers gracious living, ideal weather, and being chased by a rhino and an elephant at two different game reserves. Not one to enjoy African safaris, Yvonne always felt more at home in the concrete jungle of



Central London. She attended the Language Tuition Centre in London. Her diploma qualifications included interpreter/translator in French and English and additional study in German. She has worked for several Fortune 500 companies and organized international conferences in London and abroad. Yvonne met her American husband in England's capital, where they married 18 months later.

The couple then moved to Orlando and worked for a Winter Park real estate company before starting their own business in property and mortgages in 1984. But language and literature--not figures--have always filled her life. Yvonne earned a degree in English and Organizational Communications from Rollins College, and graduated summa cum laude. An award-winning author, Yvonne now is completing four historical books in her children's Apple Tree series (inspired by her son, initiated in the Lower East Side of New York City, and also set in the Catskill Mountains region of upstate New York). Her first book, Out of the Apple Orchard, was adapted for the stage with concert readings in New York and Orlando. A Tony-award winning producer directed the play at the Orlando Repertory Theatre in December 2016. Her second book in the series will be released in 2019, followed by a workshop of the play adaptation later in the year. The New York premiere is scheduled as a two-act play in November 2020 with the same award-winning team.

Yvonne enjoys reading, traveling and making a difference through creative expression. She also has completed the manuscript for a women's fiction book, which takes place in London and Paris, two of her favorite cities in the world. Yvonne joined Newcomers in 2015 after learning about the club from her long-time friend, Ronnie Telzer. She loves the cultural attractions of Inside the Arts and has met some lovely ladies in the group.


Everyone is welcome to join our group of lovely ladies for a movie and dinner afterwards at BJ's Restaurant. Our goal is to have fun and make new friends.
