- 10. To promote sustainable farming programs initiative for citizens of Liberia;
- 11. To engage in Agricultural training programs for church leaders in animal husbandry, tree crops production, seed production, and low land farming for self-sufficiency in their Ministries;
- 12. To engage in guidance and counseling and to promote career development planning;
- 13. To improve the health care delivery services in the rural communities of Liberia;
- 14. To do any or things which organizations formed pursuant to the provisions of Not-for-Profit Corporation Act under the Association Laws of Liberia may now or hereafter engage in.

ARTICLE III DURATION

The corporation shall have perpenial existence.

ARTICLE IV ADDRESS

The principal office of the corporation shall be in Lelekpeyaa Community, City of Gbarnga Bong County, and the Registered Agent shall be "Pastor Cyrus Dorleseh Numbeh cell # +231-776-565905

ARTICLE V ADDRESS

ARTICLE VI BOARD OF ADVISORS

The number of Directors constituting the initial Board shall not be more than five (5) nor less than (3) persons and shall have the power to make policy for running the corporation. The Board of Advisors of this Organization shall be appointed by the Chairman of the Organization and shall hold office for the period of not less than Five (5) years. The Chairman of this Organization shall have also the power to remove and replace any of the Board Members for misconduct.

ARTICLE VII CORPORATE POWER

The corporation shall exercise all power necessary and convenient to effect any of the power for which NOT-FOR-PROFIT Corporation is formed in accordance with Section 2.4 of the Association Law, Title five of the Liberian Code of Law Revised 1976; and in furtherance and not in limitation of the powers conferred by status, the Board of Directors, is expressly authorized to adopt the by-laws of the corporation and to subsequently to amend or repeal same and shall reserve the right to amend, alter, or repeal any provisions contained in these articles of incorporation in the manner now or herein after prescribed by status, and all rights conferred on members herein are granted
