## AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE ELECTED OFFICE OF CITY MARSHAL

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 22.076 of the Texas Local Government Code, the City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks has determined that it is in the interest of justice to abolish the elected office of City Marshal

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 22.076 of the Texas Local Government Code, the City Council may at a future date reinstate the City Marshal as an elected or appointed position

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS:**


### SECTION 1. OFFICE ABOLISHED

That the elected office of City Marshal is hereby abolished.


### SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY

If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance of the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance, and the City Council hereby declares that it would have passed such remaining portions despite invalidity or unconstitutionality.
