Thank you for your interest in the club. The objective of the founders of the Polish American Citizens Club are to unite members in a fraternal friendship, to promote and encourage good fellowship, to assist them in case of need and provide members with the convenience of a club house. Members enjoy club events, the company of club members and use the club for special occasions. Club members work together to support club functions, community events and private parties, which serve as the main fundraising activities.

Membership requirements are simple. According to the By-Laws, to become a Regular Active member you must meet the following requirements:

- You must be a citizen of the United States or have declared intention to become a citizen. You must be of Polish or Slavic origin or decent, which means you can identify at least one ancestor who was from the region comprising Poland, Slovakia The Czech Republic and regions of surrounding countries where Slavic language is spoken. Or if you are a spouse of a regular active member regardless of your nationality.
- You must be at least 21 years of age.
- You must appear before the Board for review of your qualifications. The next board meetings can be found on our web site www.paccwhs.org/meeting-schedule
- You must be present at a regular meeting to be sworn in as a member.
- To continue as a member in “good standing” yearly dues of \$20 must be up to date.
- You must attend at least three (3) club meetings over the course of the year (club meetings fall on the last Friday of each month at 7:00pm, except November – February, during those months the club meetings are held on the last Sunday of each month at 2:00pm.)
