



1. What does the fee include?

The fee includes initial consultation, the writing of the ceremony and any amendments, the performance of the ceremony and a copy of the ceremony paperwork.

2. Do the fees vary?

Celebrant fees vary widely and some increase prices dependent on the elements of the writing process and meetings or the mini ceremonies included mine is a flat rate fee.

3. What additional costs are involved?

If your ceremony is planned to take place abroad then flight/accommodation costs will be discussed accordingly.

4. What are your qualifications?

I have trained with the Fellowship of Independent Celebrants <http://www.foic.org.uk/> but have had a career organizing entertainment and events for over 14 years which has included public speaking to groups in excess of 500 people.

5. Is a deposit required?

To secure your wedding date a deposit must be paid once you have reviewed the consultation notes. We will send you a booking form and you simply pay a deposit by cheque or BACS payment to complete your booking. This now allows me to commence writing your ceremony.

6. How many meetings are included?

There is no limit to the amount of email and telephone contact given but meetings in person or via skype usually only require one or two.



7. What resources do you use to write our ceremony?

Based on the information you provide and an extensive catalogue of readings, poems and music we have available we are able to create your ceremony unique to you as a couple.

8. Can we write our own wedding vows?

Yes of course but this is not a must. I can provide support should you need it. This is your day and we want to help make it as special to you both as possible. We can offer examples and suggestions for you to use and edit as required. Alternatively you can repeat after me and simply say I do if you wish.

9. What does the ceremony include?

This will be discussed with you but there are several mini ceremonies such as the unity candle, sand ceremony or hand fasting that can be included as part of your ceremony in addition to readings and vows etc

10. Will we see a draft of the ceremony?

Yes a draft will be provided and can be amended as many times as required in order for you to be totally happy with it.

11. Is a rehearsal required?

This is dependent on your ceremony and you as a couple. Often a final Skype meeting is enough to discuss any final points.

12. How long before the ceremony will I arrive?

I will always arrive at least 45 minutes before in order to set the area as required and discuss with key people involved. I only book one ceremony per day in order to put you at ease.

13. How will I be dressed?

I usually wear a suit, but can be directed by yourselves as I am there to blend in and ensure you are the focus.
