Minutes of the BAQG February 2021 General Meeting – Kelly Gibson – Secretary

President Janie DeStefano called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm, welcoming members and guests.

Janie called for a motion to accept the BAQG proposed 2021 budget. Annette Kuder made a motion to accept the budget. A vote was conducted and the proposed budget for 2021 was accepted. Janie asked Annette Kuder to discuss the 2021 auction. Annette proposed postponing the guild's upcoming auction from May 2021 to November 2021 to help with attendance and participation since more people are expected to have COVID vaccines by then. Annette asked if anyone wanted to discuss. Vicki Carroll made a motion that the auction date be moved to November 2021. Angie Brown seconded the motion. The auction will be held in November 2021. Patti Macon discussed upcoming community service projects. The guild will be supporting the Baytown Homeless Shelter (Shelter). The Shelter has provided a list of items they need. The guild will be collecting cleaning supplies at the March meeting to take to the Shelter. The guild will also be supporting the Baytown Police Department Domestic Violence Unit. They need tote bags. Patti has a pattern, but any pattern for a tote bag can be used. There are free patterns for tote bags on Pinterest. They also need blankets, toys and books. Gloria Hill presented the Treasurer's report. The Audit Committee (Ricky Shelton, Connie Litteer and Rhonda Lawrence) completed its reviews of the BAQG 2020 books and deemed the books are accurate and in good order. Janie stressed to the membership the guild needs to make a decision about its next quilt show.

Connie Schofield presented a scrapbook to Jane Ott that covered guild activities over the past two years when Jane was President. Janie presented drawing prizes. BAQG had six guests tonight. Suzanne McCallum won the guest drawing. BAQG had 32 members present. Linda McPike won the member drawing. Jeannie Cross won the nametag drawing. Janie advised our guests that meetings typically include snacks and drinks as hospitality as well as a tool demonstration but the Guild has temporarily stopped these activities due to COVID. Beautiful quilts were displayed during Show and Tell. Becky Trigg displayed a heart block quilt that she completed as part of a block of the month activity. Connie Schofield, Grace Hans, Barbara Staten, Stephanie Baggot and Crystal Arthur also had beautiful quilts to show to members.

Janie presented prizes to the three winners of the mini-affle. The guild's donation quilt was displayed to guild members. This beautiful quilt was made by Connie Schofield and Delores Ellis. Janie introduced tonight's speaker, Cyn Wilde, the owner of Quilter's Cottage in Richmond, Texas. Cyn learned to quilt from her grandmother and from those lessons she in turn teaches hand quilting. She has taught quilt workshop on cruises. She is a Deb Tucker and Laura Heine instructor. She really likes the tools and techniques developed by Deb Tucker. A trunk show was included in Cyn's presentation. She showed us some of her very first quilts as well as a wide variety of her more recent projects.
