Commemorative Paver Donation Form

**Section I. Brick Information**

The Brighton Veteran’s Memorial is located in Downtown Brighton, Michigan on the Mill Pond. Commemorative Pavers may be purchased by any individual to honor a United States Veteran and will be placed at the Memorial on the “Veterans’ Walk of Honor”, or an area hear by as expansion allows. Each Commemorative Paver is a 4” x 8” Unilock Paver which can be engraved with a maximum of 17-18 characters per line on three (3) lines. The total cost for each engraved paver is \$115.00 (\$100.00 for the paver and \$15.00 for engraving).
