



FEBRUARY PHLOCKING

Our February Phlocking will be held on Sunday, February 28th from 3 to 6 pm at the Caddyshack Bar & Grill, 3122 Golfview Road, across from Harder Hall in Sebring. Our featured artist will be none other than John Frinzi, award winning singer songwriter who will be opening for the Meeting of the Minds in November.

SPEAKING OF JOHN FRINZI - THIS JUST IN FROM ROB HILL - CO-CHAIR FOR MOTM 2021

Frinzi and MOTM Agree to Terms After Breaking Stalemate Over Hair and Makeup Contract

Key West, FL - John Frinzi has agreed to terms to appear at Meeting of the Minds 2021 this fall. The singer and MOTM Co-Chair Bill Connolly made the announcement in a jointly issued press release and press conference early today. Reports earlier this month suggested the parties were at an impasse over the terms of Frinzi's hair and makeup contract riders. In a *Rolling Stone* magazine interview based on a story originally reported in *Cosmetics for Hipsters Monthly*, several anonymous sources had reported that the negotiations had shut down following tense discussions over hair product budget and the extent of Frinzi's paid hair and cosmetics staff for the event. At the press conference, Connolly downplayed the tensions.

"Obviously no one understands the importance of having experienced cosmetics professionals and quality products more than I do," he told reporters. "We understand John has a substantial phlock of admirers in a certain demographic that expects him to look good, and we've come to an agreement that we think will satisfy those people without using up so much of the budget that we can't afford to pay the other performers." Frinzi agreed while declining to comment on the difficulties in the negotiations.

"We are all phriends here," he insisted. "But business is business, and my business is not just sounding good, it's looking good. Anyone who thinks I just wake up in the morning looking this good has obviously never slept at my house." The snag in the negotiations, Connolly added, related to both the number of staff assigned to Frinzi and the duration of the assignment. Earlier reports suggested Frinzi had insisted on having two staffers assigned to him for the duration of the five day event, though he likely will perform only once. Although the terms of the final contract were not released, MOTM Attorney "Sandbar Steve" Mitchell confided in associates that MOTM agreed to a larger staff in exchange for Frinzi's concession to just one dedicated hair and makeup staff on non-performance days and for his dropping his demand that MOTM reimburse him for his Botox injections scheduled for October.

"Without commenting on the specifics, I can tell you that it's not in the economic interests of the event to be paying for any artist to get dolled up to go play a set at the **Smoking Tuna**," Connolly noted. "If Charley wants John's best look, he needs to pay for that s— out of his own budget."

Privately, Connolly has complained that he's had trouble in the past booking female artists for events at which Frinzi is also featured. Frinzi reportedly ties up the entire hair and makeup staff for hours even on days when he's not performing.

"People don't always appreciate the daily challenges of being a pin-up idol," Frinzi said. "I'm on duty twenty-four-seven, and I can't just be walking around looking like Don Middlebrook or some other rock star who can make it on the strength of talent alone. I need to bring the superficial, and that costs money. I can deliver the swooning female fans, but you gotta deliver the do-re-mi."
