
Sunday School Newsletter – August 2019

POLICY ON BORROWING EQUIPMENT FOR USE BY IMMANUEL MEMBERS:

Members of Immanuel may borrow tables, chairs, etc. from Immanuel Lutheran Church for personal use with the following provisions. We ask that you please contact the church office at least 48 hrs. in advance to reserve items and schedule pick-up & return.

Can you spare some time?

- 1. All items must be signed out & returned through the church office.
- 2. All items need to be returned within a few days after usage.
- 3. Items must be returned clean.

Can you lend a hand?

 Items must be returned in the same condition when borrowed or they need to be replaced by the borrower immediately. The Property Committee will have authority regarding condition issues.

We suggest table cloths or protective covering on tables.

July 29, 2019 – Meeting highlights Cooperative Ministry Update to Immanuel Members

Greetings of Peace to all,

The Cooperative Ministry Team and the Council are sharing this update with the Immanuel congregation to keep you informed of the efforts made thus far since our 6/24 meeting and to share the plans for the next steps. These next steps involve negotiating the details of a formal written agreement that will enable us to move forward with the Coop. Ministry model here at Immanuel. We are, of course, extremely thankful for your prayers and your support and we are aware of the extra time commitment that these efforts have required for those called to serve in these negotiations.

We want our members to know that in the recent discussions with the team members and the Bishop, the Bishop proposed a tentative agreement for all the churches to consider and sign. That agreement spurred numerous concerns for not only the Immanuel team members and in turn the Immanuel Council, but some of the other team members as well. Some of our specific concerns involve the 34% increased financial commitment proposed as well as the calculations used to establish Immanuel's revised financial portion of the cooperative. In addition, we are also continuing to work out scheduling details for vacation coverage (four weeks each for Pastor Thompson and Deaconess Guthrie), and Summer service timing. Finally, we are working on establishing the correct wording and timeline for ending the proposed three year commitment, if it is deemed necessary. All of these areas of the proposed tentative agreement drafted by the Bishop are somewhat different than those proposed to you at our Special Congregational Meeting and therefore warrant further discussion and negotiation prior to proceeding.

Immanuel members voted to support this ministry effort at our Special Congregational Meeting held on 6/23 based on the information available to us at the time. The details to establish the structure that accommodates this ministry model are taking time and as such we will not be able to begin, as anticipated, on 9/8.

Moving forward Pastor Thompson and Deaconess Guthrie will be presiding at both services on August 18th as planned so you will have the opportunity to become more familiar with them and their ministry style. Our next Coop. Ministry Team meeting is scheduled for August 26th. We will continue to schedule presiders, as we have been doing, through September and possibly into October and we will not change our early service schedule until further notice.

We realize that this delay is not what we anticipated but you entrusted us with representing Immanuel in these Cooperative Ministry efforts and we are honoring that trust by delaying implementation to work out the details that are in question.





Our Stepping Stones - Learn to Earn Program is an education-based system of earning the things young parents need for their baby while helping them gain knowledge, skills and tools for a healthier life. This program is intended for both individuals and couples.

HOW IT WORKS

Parents will earn "Credits" by keeping appointments with a staff member who takes them through a short lesson. The lessons are taught using a series of videos that cover many important topics. Participants may cash in earned credits immediately after completing the lesson, or save them up towards a larger item.
