



## Venice Art & Collectibles Market

Welcome to the Gondolier Booster Club's Venice Art & Collectible Market. We're glad to have you! Your market fees go to the Gondolier Booster Club, a non-profit organization supporting the students and faculty of Venice High School.

As a new Vendor you probably have a few questions regarding the market operations.

- The market is held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays of the month.
- The sizes of the spaces are approximately 18
- ' x 18' – there are a few irregular size and shape spaces that periodically come available, however these spaces are the same price.
- The price of a space is currently \$25 per market.
- Most of the spaces can accommodate parking for one car. If you have additional vehicles they must be parked in the lot behind the school. The exception is any space on grass. Those spaces have no parking. Vendors may unload at the spot, but must then park in the back lot.
- Vendors may NOT park on Venice Blvd. These spaces are for food trucks and customers. Please respect this rule. Easy access to parking brings more customers to YOUR business.
- All children under 12 must be supervised by an adult
- You may pay in advance by check. The check must be received prior to the market, so if you choose this option it is advisable to mail it at least one week in advance.

- Vendors may not sell weapons (real or replica) drug paraphernalia, stolen merchandise, counterfeit goods, or adult material. Market management has the final say in what can be sold at the market.
- Vendors need a California Reseller's Permit if they sell at the market more than two times per year. BRING an extra copy of the permit with you for the market's file. Permits are free and applications can be downloaded from [www.boe.ca.gov](http://www.boe.ca.gov)
- Vendors must clean up their area before they leave for the day. Vendors who leave trash or unsold merchandise in their spot will lose their selling privileges
- We do not currently have tables or chairs for rent, so you must bring your own. It is also advisable to bring some type of shading device or umbrella.
- In the event of heavy rain, the market will be rescheduled for the following month.
- If you like your space you may reserve it for the next month by paying in advance at the current market. This reserves your spot. If you do not reserve your spot it may be given away to another vendor.
- If you cannot make it but have paid in advance, call 424 272-0361 prior to the market, and let us know. Otherwise it will be assumed that you no longer wish to be a vendor and your spot could be given away.
- If you would like to change spots, speak to the manager about availability.

Vendors must abide by the rules or they will lose their selling privileges. In the event of disputes, the decision of Market Management is final.
