- Class conflicts may occur. Please schedule carefully. No refunds for missed classes. Refunds for classes will be given only in case of accident or illness to a terrier or owner, or for bitches in heat.
- Dogs must be leashed or crated at all times.
- ❖ No puppies under three months of age permitted on the grounds.
- **❖** No puppy sales are permitted on the trial site.
- ❖ Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated at any time during the trial. Anyone demonstrating poor sportsmanship will be dismissed from the grounds.
- ❖ Provide all certificates for those classes for which they are required
- ❖ JRTCA rulebook can be downloaded at www.therealjackrussell.com
- ❖ A COPY OF JRTCA MEMBERSHIP CERTIFICATE MUST BE PRESENTED

Important Notice:

Every effort was made to schedule classes so you may enter as many events as possible. It is your responsibility to be aware of scheduled classes, in each division, and to be on time for every class. The Committee will not be responsible for conflicts that may occur, and classes WILL NOT be held up due to conflicts between events. Please review the class list and agenda and plan your classes accordingly!

* The \$7.00 JRTCA fee for non-registered/recorded terriers will not be charged to those entering only non-sanctioned classes, nor to those first joining the JRTCA at the trial.

Directions to Trial Site:

From I-40: Take Exit#16 South (Germantown Rd.) Continue on Germantown Road for 8 miles until it narrows to 2 lanes at Poplar Pike (traffic light). Turn left on Poplar Pike and the show grounds will be approximately \(^1/4\) mile on the right.

From I-240: Exit Poplar Avenue East to Germantown Road (BP Station on South Corner). Turn right on Germantown Road, then left on Poplar Pike (traffic light). The show grounds will be approximately ½ mile on the right. *Directions are also on Google maps*.

GENERAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

- 1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
- 2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT organization. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified, and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
- 3. Entries MUST be within the 10 15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
- 4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
- 5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
- 6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family*, Open or Working Conformation. *Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed / neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
- 7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
- 8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling classes.
- 9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division or section in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division. (Exception Ring 2 Nationals judge may have terriers shown in Ring 1)
- 10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
- 11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September, 1999 will be honored.
- 12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
- 13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier Classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground and Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the ring/den steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC certificate signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- 14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered and asked to leave the trial site. (This applies to RV's and campers, if at the same address as the trial grounds) (01/22)
- 15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
- Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the National Trial Committee.
- 17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded.
- 18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
- 19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
- 20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.therealjackrussell.com).
- 21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties, which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.
- 22. All dogs brought to the trial must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
- 23. Judges may not eat, smoke, or use cell phones while at their events.
- 24. THE JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS!

RACING

RULES:

- All terriers, including 4-6 month puppies, must be muzzled!
- Plastic muzzle or close-ended cloth muzzles only. No Baskerville muzzles, figure eight or open-ended muzzles will be allowed. Colored basket and colored softie muzzles are not allowed. Black, brown, clear, or white muzzles are acceptable.
- Any entry going around the jumps, jumping out of the racetrack or not wearing a secured muzzle will be disqualified from that race and, therefore, shown as not finishing that race.
- All requests for height measurement must be made by 8 AM to the racing judge. Terriers will be measured with approved JRTCA wickets.
- · Qualifications for Championships Runoffs: Terrier must place first in a flat or hurdle final to qualify for championship run offs. A terrier MUST ENTER AND FINISH in both, at least one flat race AND one hurdle race at the beginning level based on trial entries (heat, semi, final). A terrier must continue to advance, if qualified, to all additional semi-final heats up to the final championship race. If injured, the terrier is then finished and cannot race in the final. A FINISHED race is when the terrier runs down the track unassisted (by owner or anyone else) with a secured muzzle to the backside of the barrier. In the event a terrier does not meet all the above criteria, the second place terrier in the final of that class (either flats or hurdles) will qualify for the championship run off if they meet the criteria as outlined
- Adult terriers may not cross-enter between Adult, Veteran and Senior Racing Classes.

Racing Course Set-up: 300-foot track; up to 14-inch-high foam jumps; foam catch barrier; "Joe Bag" as the back stop; 30 foot catch pen with trained, experienced catchers. Designed for the safety of our terriers, our goal. Catchers are members of Briar Crest Key Club

of dog is NOT considered.

Class 44: Child GTG. Open to any child ages 5-9 handling a JRT. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of

G-T-G. Terrier to run through a 10-foot Novice liner, time NOT to be considered. (Non-Sanctioned)

Class 45: Youth Handler. Open to any youth ages 10-16 handling an adult JRT. Judged on youth's ability to present his/her dog and

knowledge of JRTs. Quality of dog NOT considered.

Class 46: Youth G-T-G: Open to any youth ages 10-16 handling an adult JRT. Judged on youth's ability to present his/her dog and

knowledge of G-T-G. To be run through a 10-foot Novice liner, time NOT to be considered.

Class 47: Youth Working Judge's Choice: Open to any youth handler ages 10-16 handling an adult JRT. Judged on youth's knowledge of

hunting and the working terrier and ability to answer questions presented by a JRTCA working judge; no terrier to accompany

handler to class.

Class 48: Child Handler High Point and Reserve: Awarded to the highest scoring child and runner-up in Classes 43 and 44.

No entry fee. (Non-Sanctioned)

Class 49: Youth Handler High Point and Reserve: Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in Classes 45, 46, 47.

No entry fee.

Points for Child and Youth High Point and Reserve classes will be awarded as follows:

1st = 8 points; 2nd = 6 points; 3rd = 5 points; 4th = 4 points; 5th = 3 points; 6th = 2 point; Participation = 1 point.

Exhibitors must compete in a minimum of Youth Handling and Youth Go-to-Ground to qualify for the Youth High Score & Reserve. In case of a tie, it will be broken by a handling class to be held in the Conformation Ring; Judge to be decided by the Trial Chairperson.

CONFORMATION

RULES:

- · Cross entering is not permitted within or between the Open and Working Sections.
- Exhibitors participating in the working Classes <u>must submit the appropriate JRTCA Paperwork with entries</u>. The judge may require a copy of the Natural Hunting Certificate (NHC) to be presented to the ring steward at the time of judging.
- · Spayed or neutered terriers may only compete in Miscellaneous Conformation classes.
- · Child / Youth Conformation will start first.

No cross-entering is permitted within Open Section. Cross-entering is NOT permitted between the Open Section and Working Section.

Class 87: Bred by Exhibitor Dog. Open to any adult JRT dog owned & bred by the exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder under whose

kennel prefix the terrier is registered or member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 88: Dogs, 1 year & older, 10" up to 12½"

Class 89: Dogs, 1 year & older, over 12½" up to 15"

Class 90: Best Open Dog & Reserve. Open to 1st & 2nd place winners of classes 87 through 89. No entry fee.

Class 91: Bred by Exhibitor Bitch. Open to adult JRT bitch owned & bred by exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder under whose kennel

prefix the terrier is registered or a member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 92: Bitches, 1 year & over, 10" up to 12½"
Class 93: Bitches, 1 year & over, over 12½" up to 15"

Class 94: <u>Best Open Bitch & Reserve</u>. Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 91 through 93. No entry fee.

Class 95: Best Open Terrier & Reserve. Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 90 and 94. No entry fee.

GO-TO-GROUND

Class 96: <u>Pre-Novice Puppy.</u> Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; mark quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 97: Novice Puppy. Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Class 98: Novice Adult. Open to Jack Russells one year of age or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Class 99: Open Puppy. Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship GTG. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial or may continue competing in Open Puppy GTG class at future trials. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 100: Open Adult. Open to Jack Russells one year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work quarry

continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 101: Puppy Championship. Open to Jack Russells, 6 up to 12 months which have earned 100% in an Open Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.) Once a puppy competes in Puppy Championship GTG they cannot return to Open.

Adult Championship Certificate GTG

Open to any adult Jack Russell, one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Class 102: 10" up to 12½" Class 103: Over 12½" up to 15"

Veteran Championship Certificate GTG

Open to any adult Jack Russell 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Class 104: 10" up to 121/2"

Other Earthdog GTG: (Non-Sanctioned classes 109, 110, & 111)

Class 109: Novice Puppy / Adult. Open to any Earthdog, 6 months and older **who has NOT scored 100% in this class at ANY previous trial.**(One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry.)

Class 110: Open Puppy / Adult. Open to any Earthdog, 6 months and older who have scored 100% in the Novice class at ANY previous trial, (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Class 111: Other Earthdog Championship and Reserve GTG: Open to any Earthdog, 6 months and older who have scored 100% in the Open class at ANY previous trial, 1st & 2nd place winners are the Champion and Reserve. (One second per foot to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute, without a break in work & without leaving the quarry. Puppies may leave and re-enter the earth once.)

SUPER EARTH G-T-G

A challenging GTG course with a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier, 6 months and older. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and reenter several times until the quarry is reached then must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another without penalty.

Rules: no prior schooling; only the dog is allowed in the fenced area; dog owner may give verbal commands only; the clock starts the moment the dog is released. CROSS ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN Super Earth Classes.

- Class 112: 6 up to 12 month Open Puppy Super Earth. Puppies receiving a 100% score in this Class at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee enter the Puppy Championship class at this trial OR may continue competing in the Open Puppy SE Class at future trials. Open Puppy Super Earth Class is not open to any Puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship Super Earth.(01/22)
- Class 113: 10" up to 12 ½" Open Adult Super Earth. Open to terriers one year and older. May continue to compete in Open Adult class until they apply for and receive their Trial Certificate. A terrier achieving 100% in the open adult class is eligible to apply for a Trial Certificate when terrier is

- registered or recorded with the JRTCA.
- Class 114: Over 12 ½" up to 15" Open Adult Super Earth. Open to terriers one year and older. May continue to compete in Open Adult class until they apply for and receive their Trial Certificate. A terrier achieving 100% in the open adult class is eligible to apply for a Trial Certificate when terrier is registered or recorded with the JRTCA.
- Class 115: 10" up to 12 ½" Open Veteran Super Earth. Open to terriers six years and older. May continue to compete in Open Adult class until they apply for and receive their Trial Certificate. A terrier achieving 100% in the open adult class is eligible to apply for a Trial Certificate when terrier is registered or recorded with the JRTCA.
- Class 116: Over 12 ½" up to 15" Open Veteran Super Earth. Open to terriers six years and older. May continue to compete in Open Adult class until they apply for and receive their Trial Certificate. A terrier achieving 100% in the open adult class is eligible to apply for a Trial Certificate when terrier is registered or recorded with the JRTCA.
- Class 117: 6 up to 12-month Puppy Champion Super Earth. Open to 6 up to 12 month JRT puppies which have earned 100% in an Open 6 up to 12 month Puppy Super Earth Class at this or a previous JRTCA Trial. A copy of a 100% score sheet must be presented with pre-entry or be shown to den steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Super Earth Champion and Reserve. Once a puppy competes in Puppy Championship SE they cannot return to Open Puppy Super Earth.
- <u>Adult Certificate Super Earth</u>: Open to Jack Russell Terriers, one year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class.

First and Second Place winners will be Adult Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 118: <u>10" up to 12 ½"</u>

Class 119: Over 12 1/2" up to 15"

<u>Veteran Certificate Super Earth,</u> Open to Jack Russell Terriers, six years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class
