



Symbols of the Holy Spirit (cont.)

...Besides the proper name of the Holy Spirit we also find many other symbols by which it is known and manifested throughout history, in literature, in scriptures and tradition...

*The Hand.* Jesus heals the sick and blesses little children by laying hands on them. In his name the apostles will do the same. Even more pointedly, it is by the Apostles' imposition of hands that the Holy Spirit is given. The *Letter to the Hebrews* lists the imposition of hands among the "fundamental elements" of its teaching. The Church has kept this sign of the all-powerful outpouring of the Holy Spirit in its sacramental epiclesis.

*The finger.* "It is by the finger of God that [Jesus] casts out demons." If God's law was written on tablets of stone "by the finger of God," then the "letter from Christ" entrusted to the care of the apostles, is written "with the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone, but on tablets of human hearts." The hymn *Veni Creator Spiritus* invokes the Holy Spirit as the "finger of the Father's right hand."

*The Dove.* At the end of the flood, whose symbolism refers to Baptism, a dove released by Noah returns with a fresh olive-tree branch in its beak as a sign that the earth was again habitable. When Christ comes up from the water of his baptism, the Holy Spirit, in the form of a dove, comes down upon him and remains with him. The Spirit comes down and remains in the purified hearts of the baptized. In certain churches, the Eucharist is reserved in a metal receptacle in the form of a dove (*columbarium*) suspended above the altar. Christian iconography traditionally uses a dove to suggest the Spirit.



SAINT ANTHONY OF PADUA  
Feast Day June 13

Who isn't fond of St. Anthony or hasn't asked him for help at some point in their lives to find something that was lost, seek help in a difficult situation or even in spiritual matters. Even members of other denominations know of his helpfulness! He must be the most overworked saint in

heaven...especially now that we have all those wonderful cell phones and other electronic treasures to loose. He is effectively the "lost and found" department of heaven. In his lifetime he was probably better known for his powerful preaching, expert knowledge of scripture, and undying love and devotion to the poor and the sick. He was a great friend of St. Francis of Assisi in these regards as well. Curiously, he died at age 35 from ergotism (not egotism...) which has come to be called "Saint Anthony's Fire" which is caused by exposure to a toxin produced by fungus infected grain and was common in the Middle Ages. It was named for St. Anthony and the monks of the Order of St. Anthony who were particularly successful at treating this ailment. It is still common in some parts of the world today.
