

# What is This Sacrament Called (Continued)

From last week: [...The Holy Eucharist completes Christian initiation. Those who have been raised to the dignity of the royal priesthood by Baptism and configured more deeply to Christ by Confirmation participate with the whole community in the Lord's own sacrifice by means of the Eucharist. At the Last Supper, on the night he was betrayed, our Savior instituted the Eucharist sacrifice of his Body and Blood...The inexhaustible richness of this sacrament is expressed in the different names we give it. Each name evokes certain aspects of it. It is called...]

Holy Communion, because by this sacrament we unite ourselves to Christ, who makes us sharers in his Body and Blood to form a singe body. We also call it: the holy things (ta hagia; sancta) -- the first meaning of the phrase "communion of the saint" in the Apostles' Creed--the bread of angels, bread of heaven, medicine of immortality,

Holy Mass (Missa), because the liturgy in which the mystery of salvation is accomplished concludes with the sending forth (missio) of the faithful, so that they may fulfill god's will in their lives.



# THE FÁTIMA CHILDREN

May 13, is the traditional anniversary of Our Lady's visits to the three shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal. No effort was made initially towards their canonization as it was felt that they could not fully understand heroic virtue or practice it repeatedly, both of

which are essential for canonization. Bishops petitioned the Pope to make an exception, however. They wrote that "the children were known, admired and attracted people to the way of sanctity and that the children's canonization was a pastoral necessity for the children and teenagers of the day. They were canonized on May 13, 2017 at Fatima!
