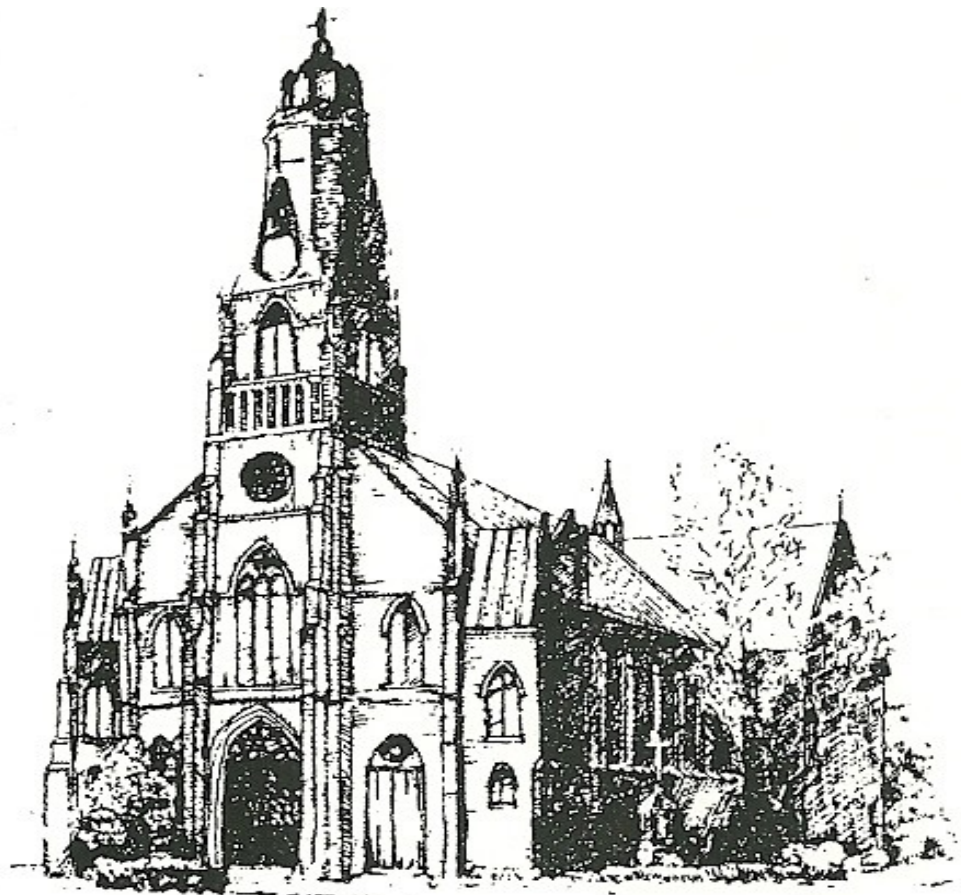

Mark the date – July 9, 2017 for the St. Albertus Picnic

By maintaining and restoring St. Albertus Historic District, we are making our Metro Detroit a better place to live. Please help us - we really do need your help: financially; with your presence at our events; and with your volunteer efforts. St. Albertus Parish was founded in 1870; the first church building was erected in 1872; the present church building was erected in 1884; and the rectory was built in 1890. So many Americans can trace their roots back to this parish and this neighborhood. Please note that we receive no financial support from any institution – religious, civic minded, or governmental. We must raise money by ourselves.

2017 projects

Continuing:

- ⌚ Celebrate masses.
- ⌚ Grounds maintenance.
- ⌚ Church boiler system maintenance.
- ⌚ Administrative functions:
 - Bill paying and accounting.
 - Membership and fundraising work.
 - Putting on fundraising dinners
 - Putting on tours and weddings.
 - Publicity
- ⌚ Rectory repairs and maintenance.
- ⌚ Church cleaning and decorating.

Special projects:

- ⌚ Front basement doors – complete.
- ⌚ Kitchen remodeling – mostly done.
- ⌚ Electrical repairs/modernization – IBEW Local 58 continues this work.
- ⌚ Sacristy ceilings – repairs have begun.
- ⌚ South side parking lot – we are being charged \$350 per month as an impervious surface surcharge. We are trying to figure out a way to substantially reduce this. We also feel that the parking lot looks bad and will try to address this.
- ⌚ School sale – we have settled on a purchaser for the school building. We tried to be selective, to choose one we thought to be the best possible neighbor and to choose one that had the resources to develop the building. The process is still ongoing. Hopefully this pending deal will turn the building into an asset for the St. Albertus Historic District.
- ⌚ Removing dirt from church basements – in progress.

Important future projects:

- ⌚ The church brickwork is in poor shape. We have a quote of \$470,000 to fix it.
- ⌚ Some exterior and interior windows are in poor shape. We have quotes upward of \$200,000 to effect repairs.
