### Handicap News

If you play a partial round, what do you do?

If you play from 7 to 12 holes, then have to quit for any reason, you can post a 9 hole round. If you play less than nine, you complete your card with net pars. So if you didn't finish the 8th hole and it was a par 4. If you have a stroke on that hole, you would score it as a 5. No stroke, then score it as a 4..

If you play at least 13 or more holes, then post an 18 hole score using the net par rule for scoring the holes you did not play.

SCGA and USGA are still having issues with posting from club computers. Until this is resolved, I will be checking scores from skins games and tournaments, to make sure everyone's scores are showing up properly. I'll send an email when we know for sure that everything is fixed.

We had a total of 65 players tee it up in four fields, A,B,C & D, for the April Individual low net tournament. As usual we had a number of special time and pairing request and I did my best to give you what you asked for. Remember to put your request in each time you sign up for a tournament. I



**do not, repeat, I do not** carry over your requests from month to month. Once in a while, I have to bounce someone around to make it all work out.

This month, I would like to commend Brian King for being such a good sport as I changed his tee time two times. When I called him he agreed to the first change. Then at the course I asked him to change again. **He never complained and was very gracious about it. Thanks Brian.**

After the audit, we had ties for first in both the C and D flights. These were both due to addition or subtraction errors. While errors like these are the responsibility of the committee I would like remind the players to spend just a minute to check over their cards for adding up the front nine, back nine, eighteen, and the subtraction of their handicap. Fred Wallace was on hand at the scoreboard checking for signatures and general scorecard marking. Thanks Fred. Special thanks to Kevin for his usual outstanding work on the scoreboard.

Congratulations to the winners in all flights, you can check your positions on the results page.

### Tournament scorecard marking tip:

- Record only **gross scores** in the main scoring line. We do not use or need slash net scores on this line since they are not used in tournament skins. If we have a tournament where net scores are needed, such as a two man or four man event, we will provide a **net scoring line** specifically for them. Then, generally, I would prefer dots to indicate where the player should take his strokes.

Our May tournament is a two man Modified Pinehurst event. Get your partner lined up and sign up early. It is only a short time until May 14<sup>th</sup> so don't wait too late to get your entry in to me. It is difficult when people sign up late because once the field has been set it can affect everyone if I have to make changes. This is especially true in a partner event.

**Etiquette Tips for Cart Drivers-** For the good of the game (and good old common sense): If you are guilty of any of the following, please try to change your habits for the good of all players.

- Go to the shortest drive first and let you or your partner out to hit the ball. Then drive to the second ball. Don't drive all the way up to see where you hit it and then drive all the way back to the short ball. This is a waste of time.
- When two balls are equidistant and separated laterally, let your partner out at his ball and go over to your ball. Both of you can assess your next shot at the same time allowing one to hit first.
