RULES

This is a two-day show. Showmanship, Performance and Walking Fiber classes will be held on Saturday. Halter classes will be held on Sunday.

- ➤ This show is approved by the International Lama Registry Show Division.
- All animals entered in approved classes **must be** registered with the International Lama Registry (ILR) or have an ILR Tracking Number. Failure to meet this requirement prohibits entry in the show.
- Non-Breeder llamas must be accompanied by a registration or veterinarian certificate verifying the animal is a gelding, a vasectomized male, or a spayed or non-reproductive female.
- Exhibitors must be the registered owners and make entry in the exact names (owner and animal) as shown on the registration certificate or have written permission from the owner to show that animal.
- Nursing llama mothers may not be accompanied in the ring by their babies.
- No llama under the age of five months may be shown.
- A llama ages on its birthday.
- > It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have animal(s) at the show ring promptly for their class.
- Llamas may not be moved from one class to another after halter judging has begun, except at the judge's discretion.
- Youth may exhibit only one entry **per** youth class.
- Youth may compete in Advanced Performance and Youth Performance, however, they must use a different llama.
- A llama may only be used in **one** performance division.
- Animals entered in **Production Class** may be decided after halter classes. However, they must be listed with show clerk *before* this class is held.
- > To qualify for Youth Performance Champion, the youth must show in Freestyle Obstacle, Companion PR and Trail Pack or Showmanship. They must use the same animal for all three performance classes. If showing in all four classes, the highest points in either Trail Pack or Showmanship will be used.
- To qualify for Novice or Advanced Performance Champion, the exhibitor must show in Freestyle Obstacle, Companion PR and Trail Pack. They must use the same animal for all three performance classes.
- Minimum age for a handler in any class is **seven** years old. Exhibitors under 11 years of age will NOT show intact males over the age of 18 months.
- Alpacas may compete in the llama performance classes; however, we are not offering alpaca halter classes.
- An animal may be entered in only ONE halter class. Halter classes are Miniature Llamas, Suri, Silky, Light, Medium, Moderately Heavy, Extreme Heavy, Non-Breeders.
- *** It is understood and agreed that Heartland Llama Show and Hamilton County Fairgrounds and its officials, employees and agents shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, property or animal which is caused directly or indirectly for any reason. The undersigned also agrees to hold harmless Heartland Llama Show and Hamilton County Fairgrounds for any expenses or liabilities including attorney fees.
- **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** The State of Iowa does require health papers. All animals must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within 30 days. *All exhibitors should have their vet check with the State Vet to determine any other health requirements, such as TB testing, microchipping, etc., that are required in the state the show is in.*

All activities, including meals, will be in the arena.

Once the class has entered the ring and the gate is closed, late exhibitors may not enter a class.

FEES:

CLASS FEE: \$10.00 per class
LATE ENTRY FEE: \$25.00

ILR SHOW MANAGER FEE: \$3.00 per animal
LATE ENTRY DEADLINE: April 15, 2017

ENTRY CHANGES: \$5.00 for each entry change after arrival at the show (includes adding a class, changing a class, animal substitution). As I have been getting a lot of changes after exhibitors arrive at the show, this fee <u>WILL BE</u>

enforced.

STALL FEES: \$25.00 per stall if you supply your own panels; \$35.00 per stall if we supply the panels. Most of the permanent stalls are a minimum of 9' x 9' wooden box stalls with clay floors. No more than 2 animals per stall, unless they are under one year old. Exhibitors provide their own feed and bedding (*please no straw or hay for bedding*). If you are sharing stalls with someone, please indicate this on your entry form. We will try to honor all stalling requests, however, it may not be possible as some exhibitors rent stalls and others bring their own panels. One barn is for those who bring their own panels. Stalls will be assigned on a first come-first served basis. Please request stalls for animals only. There is enough room in the aisles for tack. There are wash areas. Every barn has electricity and water nearby. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to keep their area clean at all times. **Please clean your area before you depart.**

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded through fifth place (sixth until ribbons are gone), Grand and Reserve Champions, and Best in Show.

BEST IN SHOW - PERFORMANCE

The five performance championship winners are eligible for this award. The champion with the highest number of points will win this award. The tiebreaker will be the highest number of points in the freestyle obstacle courses. Exhibitors in Novice and Advanced Performance must enter all three classes to be eligible for the performance champion.

NOVICE PERFORMANCE GUIDELINES

- 6. Novice Performance Animals: Novice Refers to the animal's ability and not the ability of the handler.
- a) Animals must show in the appropriate division. Eligibility requirements for animals to show in the Novice Division are outlined as follows:
- 1) A Novice Animal is defined as an animal who has not earned 4 or more Grand or Reserve Championships in any Performance division (Novice, Open, or Youth) in any Show Association or Open Show with a minimum of 5 in the division.
- 2) If a Novice Animal has moved to the Advanced division in any other Show Association, they must show in the Advanced division in the ILR-SD.
- ***3) It is up to the <u>Owner/Exhibitor</u> to keep a record of their animal's placements and championships and to enter the animal correctly when entering ILR-SD Performance Classes.***
- 4) Animals shown in the inappropriate division will be subject to having any placements, Awards, and Titles removed from them by the Governing Board.
