How it began

Zoey's Fund was established in memory of Zoey, a twelve year old Shih-tzu who lost her battle to a rare and aggressive form of cancer. During her illness, Zoey's family was able to keep her comfortable and extend the amount of time she had with them through the assistance and kindness of her veterinarian and other veterinary staff. Throughout the journey, it became clear that the cost of veterinary care is often out of reach for many pet parents. As a result, many pet owners who can't afford medical care are often faced with difficult, heartbreaking decisions.

Zoey's Fund is a fund for York County residents who are facing financial struggles and who need assistance with their pet's medical care. The fund is supported through public donations, local fundraising events and administered by the Pennsylvania Veterinary Foundation. The PVF is the non-profit charitable arm of the Pennsylvania Veterinary Medical Association.
