IF YOU ARE NOT READY WHEN YOUR CLASS IS CALLED YOU WILL BE SCRATCHED!

- **RULE 1. ELIGIBILITY:** Participation in the Junior Beef Cattle Division is limited to members in good standing with their 4-H Club or FFA Chapter. Exhibitors must be enrolled in, and attending, public or private elementary or secondary school or living in the Southwest Fair District. Exhibitors may be ages 9-19 and may be in their first semester of college.
- **RULE 2. OWNERSHIP OF ANIMALS:** To be eligible for competition, animals must be the sole property of the exhibitor. All animals entered for competition in the breeding classes must be entered in the name of the owner. Original registration certificates of ownership must be presented at time of check in.
- **RULE 3. ENTRY DEADLINE:** ALL JUNIOR BEEF CATTLE ENTRIES WILL CLOSE MIDNIGHT SEPT. 4th, 2019. Please bring your ShoWorks receipt with you. In all cases, the management reserves the right to accept or reject an application for entry.
- RULE 4. ENTRY FEES/FORMS: The entry fee is per head and must be paid online at time of registration. The exhibitor and animal information must complete otherwise entry will not be accepted. Late entries will NOT be accepted. ENTRY FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE. TIE OUTS ARE LIMITED AND ARE ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS. All cattle must remain inside the barn from 8AM until 8PM.
