Dressage is outdoors on Grass.

Fix-A-Test is your opportunity to ride your dressage test for a score, get immediate verbal feedback directly from the dressage judge (approx 10 min mini lesson) and then have ride your test again for another score. Your second test will count for class placing. This class will not count towards EOY awards.

Dressage classes are open to any rider/horse combination. You MUST preregister for dressage. If showing Second Level and above TOC or Eventing TOC or Fix-A-Test TOC, please write your preferred test(s) on your entry form. Ride Times will be posted on the MISHO Facebook Page before the show.

For the safety of your children and our competitors, parents are responsible for the supervision of their children & pets at all times.

Schooling available starting at 7AM in the indoor arena

Awards: Six ribbons will be awarded in each class.

There will be a High Point Champion and Reserve ribbon for the lowest score of the day.

H/J CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Leadline is open to any amateur riders. No cross-entry into other classes.

W/T Classes & Crossrail Hunters are open to all amateur/junior riders & horses. Crossrail Hunters may walk/trot over fences without penalty, but must W/T/C on the flat.

Short Stirrup Hunter is a horse or pony of any age or showing experience ridden by a Junior exhibitor who has not reached their 11^{th} birthday by December 1^{st} of the current show year. Fence height: 18"-2

Beginner Rider Hunter is a horse or pony ridden by an **amateur** exhibitor who has not won three blue ribbons over fences at any recognized show prior to December 1 of the current show year. Equitation classes are included. Ribbons won in Short Stirrup do not affect the rider's status for this division. Fence height: 2' **Children's Hunter Pony** is a pony less than or equal to 14.2 hh and is ridden by a Junior exhibitor. The same rider and/or pony may enter any equitation classes. Fence Height: Small/Med: 2' Large: 2'6"

Master Hunter is open to any horse ridden by an amateur adult exhibitor who is 50 years old or older. Riders may not cross enter any division with fences higher than 2'. Fence height 2'

Baby Green Hunter is open to any horse or pony in its first or second year of showing over fences at a recognized show. Fence height: 2'-2'3"

Low Hunter is open to any horse or pony ridden by a child/junior or an adult competitor. Fence Height: 2'3 - 2'6"

Limit Rider is a horse or pony ridden by an **amateur** exhibitor who has not won six blue ribbons over fences at any recognized show prior to December 1st of the current show year. Equitation classes are included. Height: 2'6"

OPEN, AMATEUR ADULT and CHILDRENS HUNTER may be run as one class.

Children's Hunter is a horse or pony ridden and handled in all phases of competition by a **Junior** exhibitor. The same rider/horse (pony) may not compete at the same show in any class (equitation excepted) in which the fence height exceeds 3'3". The rider may compete on a different horse or pony at the same show in any other division or section for which the rider/horse (pony) combination is eligible. Horses and ponies entered in the Child/Junior Hunter division may not cross enter into Beginner Rider Hunter, Children's Hunter Pony, or Limit Rider Hunter divisions at the same show. Fence Height -2'9''-3'

Amateur Adult Hunter is any horse or pony ridden by an amateur adult competitor. The same rider/horse (pony) may not compete at the same show in any class (equitation excepted) in which the fence height exceeds 3'3". The rider may compete on a different horse or pony at the same show in any other division or section for which the rider/horse (pony) combination is eligible. Fence Height -2'9"-3'

Open Hunter is open to any horse or pony ridden by a child/junior or an adult competitor. Fence Height: 2"9' - 3'.

All Day Ticketed Warm-Up may be entered ONE time throughout the day per rider/horse (pony) combination.

Hunter Derby – 1st Round Classic, 2nd Round Handy Hunter

The Derby will run as one class in each height option. Course will include in-andout, bending line, at least one unrelated distance and a long approach per USHJA rules. Jumps will include natural obstacles such as coops, roll tops, & brush boxes and riders will have different options for height and approach in the Handy round. To fill a class there must be at least 3 competitors. Neck sashes will be awarded for 1st through 6th place. Rider may select their height (2' or 2'6")

Newcomer Jumper is open to any horse/rider in their first or second year of showing. No rider may cross enter into any higher jumper divisions at the same show. Fence height: crossrail. This is a Table IV class. Ties are broken based on closest to optimum time.

Beginner Jumper is open to any horse/rider in its first or second year of showing in jumper classes at 2'3 or below. Fence height: .61m - .068m (2'0)

Novice Jumper is open to any horse/rider it its first or second year of showing in jumper classes 2'6" and above. Fence height: .70m - .80m (or 2'6"-2'9")

Child/Adult Jumper is open to any horse/rider combination. Fence height: .85m-95m (2'9"-3')

Jumper Derby is open to any horse/rider combination. Fence height: .85m-.95m (2'9"-3')

Table II Sec 2(a) Classes – The first round and first jump-off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. In the event of equality of faults after the first round, there will be one jump-off for first place only in which time will decide in the event of equality of faults.

Table II Sec 1 - The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. Horses with clean rounds or equal faults are classified according to their time taken to complete the course.

Power and Speed – the first half of the course is faulted. If clear, proceed to the second half of the course which is timed and faulted. Winner has fewest faults and fastest time.

Awards: Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion & Reserve ribbons will be awarded for divisions. An award will be offered for each division with at least 3 entries. There will also be **Thoroughbreds Helping Thoroughbreds** High Point trophy and award for any registered Thoroughbred in Hunters, Jumpers, and Dressage. Jockey Club papers or tattoo is required. Please notify show secretary if your horse is eligible.

Attire: Boots, breeches, & ASTM/SEI certified helmet are required. Polo shirts are allowed. Helmet must be worn at all times while mounted.
