GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOL SUPPLIES

1. Families may purchase their own school supplies **OR** have Stepping Stones Academy purchase supplies for the cost of \$50.00 per child.

Note – All families provide student backpacks, lunch containers, and water bottle – SSA is not purchasing or providing these items

SSA PURCHASE SUPPLIES

1. SSA buys supplies in bulk and shares savings with families
2. Families avoid shopping in stores or online for supplies
3. SSA sanitizes items before providing to students
4. Teachers label supplies with student names and place in desks for first day of school



PURCHASE OWN SUPPLIES

1. Please deliver supplies to SSA between July 29th and August 11th
2. Place all supplies, excluding backpack, lunch container, and water bottle, in brown, paper bag and write student name on outside of bag – Please keep backpack, lunch container, and water bottle at home until school begins
3. Do not open or label supplies. Teachers will label supplies with student names
4. Teachers will put items in pencil boxes, pencil pouches, etc ... and place in student desks - Extra supplies will be labeled with student name and kept in individual student bins/baskets until student needs them
2. Be sure to label backpack, lunch container, and water bottle with student name – Recommend using black, permanent marker
3. Supplies (i.e. crayons, scissors) remain at school - Students may not carry supplies in backpacks between home and school. Families may wish to purchase supplies for home so students may use to complete assignments or projects.
4. Only minimal items (i.e. green folder) will be carried in backpacks. Families may wish to purchase smaller backpacks than previous years.
5. Textbooks will not be taken home and will not be carried in backpacks.
6. Students remaining at home for school do not need to have supplies at school until they return to campus.

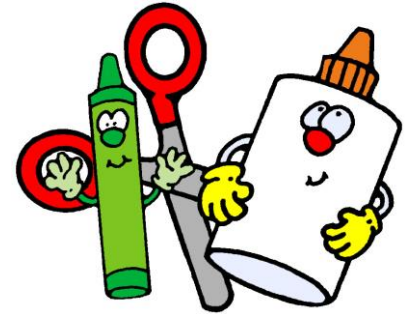

SUGGESTED SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

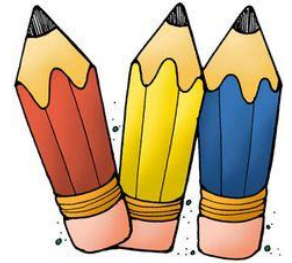
- *1 backpack
- *1 lunchbox – insulated lunch bag recommended
- *1 spill-proof water bottle with flip-top
- *1 green, plastic, two pocket folder – No binders please
- *2 boxes crayons – 24 count – Crayola brand recommended
- *2 sets water colors – 8 count – Crayola brand recommended
- *2 sets washable markers – thick point – Crayola brand recommended
- *1 pair scissors – Fiskars brand recommended
- *16 glue sticks – Elmer’s brand recommended
- *1 bottle glue – Elmer’s brand recommended
- *6 containers play dough – standard size containers, any color
- *2 packages baby wipes
- *1 box Ziploc bags – quart sized
- *1 box Ziploc bags – gallon sized
- *3 boxes Kleenex
- *3 containers disinfectant wipes
- *1 complete change of clothing in a gallon sized Ziploc bag and labeled with child’s name





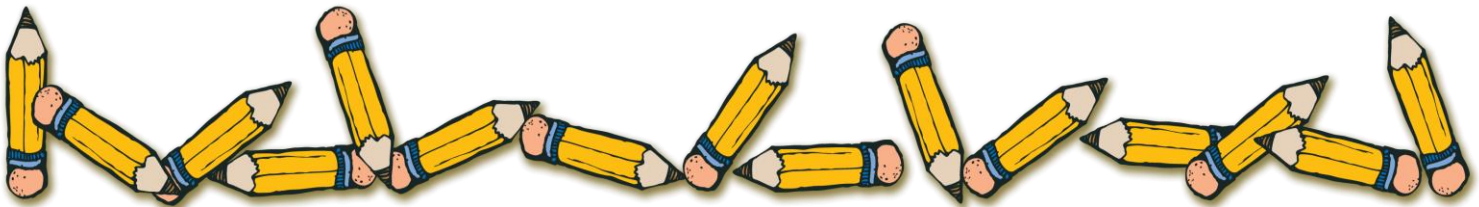
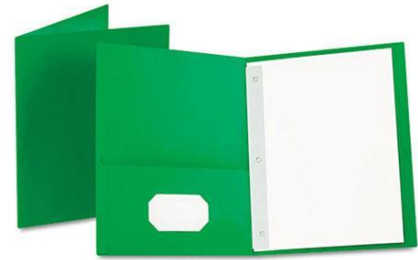
K – 8TH GRADES

SUGGESTED SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST



ALL K-8TH GRADE STUDENTS NEED THE FOLLOWING

- *1 backpack
- *1 lunch container (i.e. lunch box)
- *1 water bottle
- *1 green, plastic, two pocket folder with brad prongs in middle - No binders
- *1 red, plastic, two pocket folder with brad prongs in middle - No binders
- *1 plastic pencil box
- *1 pencil pouch – zipper style
- *36 #2 pencils – Ticonderoga brand recommended - No mechanical pencils
Note – 4th-8th grades may use mechanical pencils – Need 12 mechanical pencils with 3 boxes pencil refill lead – SSA not providing mechanical pencils
- *3 pink erasers
- *12 dry erase markers – thick point – any color - Expo brand recommended
- *1 pkg. 12 colored pencils – Crayola brand recommended
- *1 pkg. 8 or 10 markers – thick point – Crayola brand recommended
- *1 ruler – standard and metric
- *1 pair scissors – Fiskars brand recommended
- *1 bottle glue – Elmer’s brand recommended
- *6 glue sticks – Elmer’s brand recommended
- *1 box Ziploc bags – quart sized
- *1 box Ziploc bags – gallon sized
- *3 boxes Kleenex
- *3 containers disinfectant wipes



Kindergarten Also Needs

- *1 box 24 crayons – Crayola brand recommended
- *1 change of clothing in a gallon sized Ziploc bag and labeled with child’s name
- *Needed for Home -
 - 1 set alphabet flash cards
 - 1 set addition flash cards
 - 1 set phonics flash cards
 - 1 set subtraction flash cards
 - 1 set 1-100 flash cards





1st Grade Also Needs

- *1 spiral notebook – 70 pages, wide ruled
- *1 box 24 crayons – Crayola brand recommended
- *Needed for Home - 1 set addition flash cards
 1 set subtraction flash cards

2nd and 3rd Grades Also Need

- *1 plastic, two pocket folder – any color – brad prongs optional - No binders
- *2 composition notebooks – wide ruled
- *1 box 24 crayons – Crayola brand recommended
- *Needed for Home - 1 set addition flash cards
 1 set subtraction flash cards
 3rd grade only - 1 set multiplication flash cards



4th and 5th Grades Also Need

- *1 yellow, plastic, two pocket folder - brad prongs optional - No binders
- *1 blue, plastic, two pocket folder - brad prongs optional - No binders
- *2 spiral notebooks – 70-100 pages, wide ruled
- *1 composition notebook – wide ruled
- *1 box 24 crayons – Crayola brand recommended
- *2-3 pens of each color – blue, green, red, black
- *100 white, lined 3x5 index cards
- *Needed for Home - 1 set multiplication flash cards
 1 set division flash



6th - 8th Grades Also Need

- *1 plastic, two pocket folder – any color – brad prongs optional - No binders
- *6 spiral notebooks – all different covers – 70-100 pages, college ruled
- *1 composition notebook – college ruled
- *2-3 pens of each color – blue, red, black
- *1 pkg. highlighters – 4 in package with 4 different colors – thick point
- *2 black Sharpie markers – medium point
- *7th Grade Only - 1 chair to use with desk – standard kitchen table chair, no fabric
 recommend looking at Goodwill or other discount store
 Chair provided by SSA for students not bringing chair
- *8th Grade Only – Scientific Calculator
