Health Requirements:

Llamas moved within Ohio for exhibition when presented for exhibition must show no symptoms or evidence of contagious or infectious disease. Llamas imported into Ohio for exhibition must be accompanied by a CVI (certificate of veterinary inspection) issued within thirty (30) days, not show any signs or evidence of contagious or infectious disease, & must be identified with official individual identification (registered ear tattoo, official ear tag, microchip). We will be checking health papers on out of state animals. (OAC 901:1-17-15)

Registration Requirements:

All llamas 5 months or older entered in approved halter classes, with the exception of Youth/Performance/Showmanship, must be registered with the International Lama Registry (ILR). Copies of registration papers not required but entry form must clearly show ILR # and owners' ILR Owner Code. Alpacas may enter youth/performance/showmanship.

NO PENDING REGISTRATIONS ACCEPTED!

Youth Ages: as of January 1st 2024 – Junior 7-11, Intermediate 12-14, Senior 15-19 Those that have their 7th birthday during the year are eligible to show as of that day.

Youth Exhibitors: Youth cannot enter the same animal in both the youth & open performance classes. They must take a different animal through open class. Please note Youth Shorn Fleece & Fiber Products!
