In addition to the **North Dakota State Envirothon Competition Rules and Regulations**, please note the following modifications for this year:

- Registration must be printed or typed and emailed to the North Dakota Envirothon Coordinator by February 28, 2021. Since the 2021 Competition is a virtual competition, the \$50 fee is WAIVED. Teams still need a Soil Conservation District to sponsor them.
- Late registration may not be accepted. We will only accept the first 25 teams registered. The top 6 teams from the Lewis and Clark Regional Competition are guaranteed a spot, but must register by the deadline or your spot will be given to teams on a wait list.
- Teams that paid the \$50 registration fee for the 2020 competition will be allowed to roll-over their registration fee to the 2022 competition.
- No meals or housing will be provided this year. ND Envirothon will provide t-shirts for 6 teams members (5 main and 1 alternative) and 1-2 advisors. These shirts will be mailed to all teams and must be worn during the oral presentation.
- Advisors CANNOT offer assistance during the competition except with accessing the online trail test or videoing and uploading the oral presentation.
- Teams are not to be in possession of cell phones, cameras or electronic devices during the test, except for the computer which teams are taking the test on. Electronics to video the oral presentation and computers for power point presentations are allowed for the oral presentation portion of the competition.
- Rules and regulations of the ND Envirothon are subject to change. More guidelines will be given to teams and advisors prior to the competition with regards to this new virtual format.
- The competition schedule is short and designed to mimic an in-person competition as closely as possible. Please set aside dates and times now for your team to complete the trail tests, oral presentation, and attend the awards ceremony and top 3 teams final oral presentation.
- Advisors and teams should watch for an updated Oral Presentation and Guidelines Document.
