
A MESSAGE FROM WALK #126 LAY DIRECTOR

I was originally scheduled to go on my walk in November, 2002, but because my husband had to have emergency surgery, I wasn't able to go until the following April. My sister, Debbie, was my sponsor and was really disappointed when things got delayed. But she told me God had a reason and that I would go when the timing was right. I don't know why God wanted for me to wait, maybe I wasn't ready yet. All I can say for sure is that Walk #57 changed my life in ways I could never have imagined. I knew that I wanted to come back and work, become involved and share this gift with everyone who would let me. The past seven years have been an amazing journey. When my husband, Art, became ill a month ago, we were told that if he responded to the treatments, the recovery period would be very long. My stepdaughter knew about Walk 126 and told me then that God had brought me on this Emmaus journey and that I must complete it. She promised then that she would do whatever was necessary to help with her Daddy's care and make sure I was able to complete the journey. On January 14th, God took Art home and, once again, my life has taken another turn. We never know where life will take us but we have every confidence in the One who is in control of the journey. I am thrilled and humbled beyond words to be leading Walk 126. If you haven't signed up yet to chair or co-chair a work area, please consider coming whenever you can during the weekend and sharing the gift of agape love you experienced on your walk. Help be a part in changing someone else's life.




