Legislative Section

Legislation Senate Bill 1202 is being re-introduced. This would give Pa. Game Commission the choice of opening up more Sunday hunting. If have a opinion on this let your Representatives of in your district know how you feel about this.

This what State Representative will be voting on real soon, make sure you let them know how you would like them to support or not. The bill number HC., House SC., is Senate there in to committee first. View Legislation at: www.legis.state.pa.us. Find Your Legislator at www.legis.state.pa.us.

2019 Legislation:

HCO 302 By Goodman. Expands youth hunting programs to include youth ages 12 to 17 under a new mentored junior hunting program.

HCO 323 By Zimmerman. Permits the governing body of a county to waive the fee that is imposed for the issuance of a license to carry a concealed firearm, where the applicant is an honorably discharged veteran or a person who is 65 years of age or older.

HCO 454 By Ellis. Provides for reciprocal agreements with other states allowing Disabled Veteran Annual Fishing and Hunting licenses.

HCO 494 By Warren. Requires all firearm sales to be subject to a background check.

HCO 491 By Warren. Prohibits individuals on the federal terrorist watch list from purchasing or possessing a firearm in Pennsylvania.

HCO 499 By Diamond. Provides for Sunday hunting.

HCO 547 By Cruz. Requires individuals seeking to rent a firearm at a shooting range to undergo a yearly application process that includes a background check.

HCO 555 By O'Mara. Creates a Public Natural Resources Trust Fund to be used for various conservation projects.

SCO 349 By Blake. Reduces the cost of obtaining a fishing license for in-state college students.

SCO 392 By Santarsiero. Requires gun owners to safely store firearms.

SCO 393 By Santarsiero. Prohibits school districts from arming teachers in classrooms.
