

PUBLIC NOTICE – RM of Grayson No. 184

Public notice is hereby given that the Council of the RM of Grayson No. 184 intends to adopt a bylaw under *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*, to amend Bylaw No. 2004-02, known as the Zoning Bylaw.

INTENT The proposed Zoning Bylaw amendment provides more flexible campground site regulations.

AFFECTED LAND The affected land includes all lands within the Rural Municipality.

REASON The reason for the Zoning Bylaw amendment is to lower the minimum campground site size from 150 m² (1600ft²) to 46.5m² (500ft²). This is to allow for more flexible site sizes than is currently allowed in the campground regulations in the Zoning Bylaw.

PUBLIC INSPECTION Any person may inspect the bylaws at the RM of Grayson No. 184 office located in Grayson, SK during regular office hours. Copies of the bylaw will be made available.

PUBLIC HEARING Council will hold a public hearing for the amendments on July 13th at 10:30 a.m. at the RM of Grayson No. 184 office in Grayson (131 Taylor Street). The purpose of the public hearing is to hear any person or group that wants to comment on the proposed bylaw. Council will also consider written comments received at the hearing (or delivered to the undersigned at the municipal office by July 10, 2016).
