Coupons

"This month's contribution was given to the food pantry in Jerusalem Township in Oregon. That is one of the biggest food pantries in the area. Did you see the picture in the Press newspaper about St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Oregon? They had a project titled "Oregon church on a roll to wipe out poverty". They received 6,421 rolls of toilet paper and will distribute them to all area food banks. They built a 12 foot cross and many smaller crosses out of toilet paper. Which could be seen through their glass doors on Coy Road. I'd love to see a project like this at our church.

The greatest need at so called "food" pantries are for taxable items that can't be purchased with "food" stamps. That's why I contribute a big package of Costco toilet paper and a big package of Costco paper towels each month (along with toothpaste, tooth brushes, deodorants, bar soap, shampoo, dishwashing detergent and other taxable necessities that they can't get with food stamps.) I would like to see them change the name from "food" pantries so that people will contribute taxable necessities also. As always, thanks for your help with my project! I wish you could be with me when I drop off my boxes each month. They ask that I pass along their thanks to everyone. Thank you as always."
