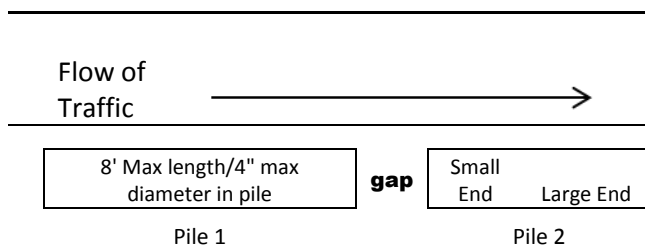

### Brush Pick-up

The FINAL brush pick-up for 2018 will be the week of: **Oct. 8**

- Pile brush at the curb pointing the cut/heavy end with the flow of traffic.
- Brush piles must run parallel with the road
- Small brush must be in an open container or CLEAR bag.
- Trim limbs per the Village Ordinance. Limbs larger than 4" in diameter or 8' in length **will not be picked up**.
- Brush must be set out at the curb by Monday at 7 a.m. of the scheduled pick-up week.
- Do not set out brush more than 5 days before the scheduled Monday.
- Brush generated by tree removal contractors will not be picked up.
- Please call with questions; brush not properly stacked will be red tagged and your responsibility to dispose of.

### Building Permits

Residents are reminded that permits must be obtained for most property improvement projects. Contact the Building Inspector or the Village Office if you are in doubt or have questions. Permit and zoning forms can be found on the website and the inspector is in the office on Monday's and as needed. When planning your construction project, please allow a two-week time frame for appropriate permits, estimates, locates, etc.

### Open Burning

Burning trash and garbage is prohibited. Burning barrels are no longer allowed within the Village of Pardeeville. Fall burning of dry leaves and other non-offensive dry yard debris is only allowed from October 1<sup>st</sup> thru November 30<sup>th</sup>. Outdoor cooking and campfires are allowed per Village Ordinance but must be supervised at all times.

Halloween "Trick or Treat" hours are set for from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. on October 31, 2018

### Leaf Disposal

Leaves will be picked up once this fall by Advanced Disposal; the week of November 5<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup>. Please follow these few simple rules:

- Leaves must be set out at the curb before 7 a.m. on Monday of the collection week.
- Do not set out bags of leaves more than 5 days before the scheduled Monday.
- Leaves **MUST** be set out in see-through bags.
- Bags should be placed immediately behind the curb of the public street for collection.
- No garden waste or grass clippings are allowed. Please compost!

If you miss the leaf pick-up, you can haul your leaves free of charge to the Wyocena Town Recycling site on Bush Road. They are open Wednesday's noon to 4:00 p.m. and Saturday's from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

### Elections & Voter Registration

#### **General Election - November 6**

The polls are open from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM. If you need to vote by absentee ballot or register, you may apply at the Village Office or by visiting [www.myvote.wi.gov](http://www.myvote.wi.gov) You must have proof of residence (driver's license, utility bill, bank statement, government document etc) that has your current street address on it to register and a photo id to vote. If registering you must be a resident for at least 10 days prior to the election.

Absentee voting is available during open office hours starting the week of September 24. Please bring photo id to obtain ballot.

If your name or address has changed you must re-register with the correct information. Any questions please contact the office!

## **Winter Parking Rules**

Winter parking rules are in effect November 15<sup>th</sup> to April 1st. Between 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., park cars on the even house numbered side of the street on even-numbered days of the month, and odd house numbered side of the street on odd-numbered days of the month. When the depth of snow reaches 3" or more during any period of 24 hours or less, a snow emergency will be declared and vehicles will need to be removed from the streets until the snow is cleared.

## **If You Have a Mailbox**

The Village of Pardeeville **WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE** for mailbox damage caused by the plowing of snow. Please make certain that your mailbox front is EVEN with or BEHIND the back of the curb and is not in need of any maintenance due to previous winters.

## **Christmas Tree Pickup**

The Village will pick up your used tree the second week of January. Place the tree at the curb by Monday, January 7, 2019.

## **Tax Collection Info**

The Village Hall will be closed the following days for the holidays:

**Dec. 24 & 25; Dec.31 and Jan.1**

For your convenience, real estate taxes can be receipted for the 2018 year if postmarked on or before Dec. 31 or placed in the drop box prior to January 2, 2019. The first half of your tax bill is due at the Village Hall by January 31, 2019 and the final payment is due at the County Treasurer's office by July 31, 2019.

## **Snow Removal**

Don't forget that you must clear the snow/ice from your sidewalk within 24 hours after the snow has stopped. **Snow/ice should not be deposited on the street.**

"Adopt-a-hydrant": If there is a fire hydrant in the right-of-way on your property, for your safety and the safety of your neighbors please remove the snow around the hydrant.

## **License Your Pet(s)**

**Please license your dogs and cats for 2019. You must bring in proof of rabies vaccination from your veterinarian's office. We will begin issuing license tags after December 15, 2018. Licenses are due by March 31, 2019!**

## **Park Shelter Rental 2019**

We will be accepting in-person shelter reservations on March 1, 2019 starting at 8:00 a.m. Reservations by phone will be taken starting at 10:00 a.m. the same day. Call 429-3121 for information about Park Shelter Rental.

## **Emerald Ash Borer**

You may have noticed that there are ash trees marked in the park; these trees are infected with Emerald Ash Borer. If you have an ash tree the best way to tell if it's infected is to look at the top, if there are dead branches then it's likely to be infected. Note these trees can be treated however its best to consult with an arborist to see if it's possible or the tree should be taken down.

## **Interested in Public Service**

The Village Board is encouraging residents to participate in their local government. There are opportunities to serve on Committees, Commissions and the Village Board. Three Village Board Trustee positions and the Village President are up for re-election in April 2019. A candidate must be a Village resident and at least 18 years of age. Interested candidates may pick up the election nomination papers from the Village office on or after Dec. 3, 2018. The filing deadline to be a candidate for Village offices is no later than 5:00 p.m. on Jan. 2, 2019. The elected officials will begin their term of office the third week of April 2019.
