### ABOUT OVERALL LATENT PRINT PROCESSING

In this 3-day (24 hour) class, attendees will be introduced to various types of evidentiary surfaces they may encounter when processing for latent impressions both on-scene and within the laboratory setting, to include: non-porous, porous, semi-porous, adhesive surfaces, and other special circumstances. Attendees will learn a variety of techniques that may be used to develop latent impressions, how to visualize impressions, and how and when to choose the appropriate processing sequence, to include the development and enhancement of blood impressions. Through an understanding of why these techniques may be used to benefit the examination process, attendees will build a knowledge base for the achieving the best product during their examinations.

This course also includes a large portion of hands-on practical exercises, where the attendees can learn and practice the application and visualization of techniques such as: Cyanoacrylate Fuming, Fluorescent Dye Stains, Iodine Fuming, 1,2 Indanedione, Ninhydrin, WetWop, Amido Black, Hungarian Red, Traditional Fingerprint Powders, Lifting techniques, and more. These techniques may be utilized in the laboratory setting, or on scene to best develop and visualize impression evidence.

This course has been approved by the IAI Latent Print and Crime Scene Certification Boards for continuing education towards the certification programs.

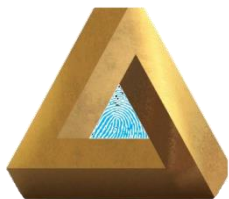
