### **Becoming saints**

Pope Francis will canonize two former popes April 27. More than a million people are expected to attend the ceremony.

#### Pope John XXIII

Born 1881, Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli Papacy 1958-1963 Died 1963

Beatified Sept. 2000 by Pope John Paul II

#### Pope John Paul II

Born 1920 Karol Jozef Wojtyla

Papacy 1978-2005 Died 2005

Beatified 2011

by Pope Benedict XVI

#### Steps to sainthood

Process of being declared a saint by the Roman Catholic Church



#### Examination

- Typically, a candidate must be dead at least five years before review
- Local bishop put in charge of investigating candidate's life
- · If deemed worthy, called "servant of God"

#### Veneration


 If investigation shows candidate lived by heroic Christian virtues, earns title "venerable"

#### **Beatification**

• If it is proved that candidate is responsible for a posthumous miracle, candidate declared "blessed"; martyrs can be beatified without evidence of miracle

#### **Canonization (sainthood)**

 After proof of a second posthumous miracle, the pope will canonize the candidate © 2014 MCT Source: AP, Catholic Online



- -Beautified in Oct. 2013 by Pope John Paul II, approved a first posthumous miracle: a 30 year old in Kolkota cured of a stomach cancer
- **Canonized** as a saint in Mar 2016 by Pope Francis after recognizing a second miracle of healing a Brazilian man with multiple brain tumors after loved ones prayed to her.

### 1. You have been raised with Christ.

Holiness is a gift, it is a gift that the Lord Jesus gives us, when He takes us to Himself, clothes us with Himself, and renders us like Himself. In the Letter to the Ephesians, the Apostle Paul affirms that "Christ loved the Church and gave Himself up for her, that He might sanctify her" (Ephesians 5:25-26). There, holiness is truly the most beautiful face of the Church: it is to rediscover oneself in communion with God, in the fullness of His life and of His love. One understands, then, that holiness is not only the prerogative of some: holiness is a gift that is offered to all; no one is excluded, it is what constitutes the distinctive character of every Christian.
