Sharon Walks 3 Days to Cure Breast Cancer!



Sharon Ellis recently participated in the Susan G. Komen Atlanta 3-Day Walk, which took place October 13th-15th. On Day 1, the 20-mile route began in Stone Mountain Park and ended at the Georgia World Congress Center where walkers and crew camped in Hall A in little pink tents. Days 2 and 3 took walkers on 40 more (hilly!) miles of scenery before ending at SunTrust Park for Closing Ceremony. 475 walkers and 225 crew raised \$1.4 million for the fight to end breast cancer. Thanks to incredibly generous family & friends, especially GCC, Sharon raised over \$5000 for the walk and was the #21 individual fundraiser for the Atlanta 3-Day.

Like the idea of participating in a "pink ribbon" event but don't feel up to starting with a 60-mile walk? Join Sharon, Rick and the "Cool Cruisers for the Cure" in the 2018 Komen Atlanta Race for the Cure! The 5K (3.1 mile) Race will be on Saturday, May 5, 2018.
