Feathered Star Class Descriptions

Beginning Crazy Quilting- 1st **Wednesdays Feb-June** Class \$10 per month 10-noon This is a beginning crazy quilting class. Each month we'll learn at least two new stitches. We'll also look at completed blocks to see how the stitches are used. As we go, we'll learn how to combine stitches and vary threads for new looks. For the first class you can either come prepared with an item you wish to stitch or you can purchase pre-made hexagons or stockings from me. *Please include a muslin base to whatever you'll be stitching on! I will also demonstrate how to prepare your own blocks. I would encourage the purchase of the book <u>Foolproof Crazy Quilting</u> or the <u>Crazy Quilt Stitches</u> pocket guide (10% discount if you're in the class). You can bring your own needles and perle cotton thread or purchase them here. Later in the class we'll add beads and silk ribbon embroidery.

1. Feb 6- Buttonhole (blanket)/ Chain

Buttonhole Wheel

Demonstrate piecing hexagons

2. Mar 6- Herringbone/ French Knot (Pistil Stitch)

Add French knots to buttonhole seams.

French knot/ bead and button clusters

3. Apr 3- Fly/ Feather

Vary Feather stitch by number of stitches per side and length of stitch

4. May 1- Stem / Spiderweb Rose/ Beads

Add beads to chain and feather stitches

5. June 5- Accordion Rose/ Stem stitch Flower/ Couching Couch variety of threads, ribbons, rick rac

While you won't create a Santa that looks exactly like mine, I'll share seam treatments and wool applique patterns you can use to create your original Santa! This class assumes you will be working at home on seam treatments between classes.

- 1. Feb 13- Piecing Santa/ Beginning Seams
 Bring *Christmas, red and green fabrics. *Sewing machine. *Muslin (2) 8" x 13"
 *Perle cotton in shades of red/green/white.
- 2. Mar 13- Applique pieces
- 3. April 10- Seam Treatments
- 4. May 8- Finishing Santa
 Bring *Sewing machine. *Polyfil stuffing *Needle and thread to match Santa fabric
 *wool for beard *beaded trim, fur, cording as desired

Fidget Quilts- Friday, Feb 1 \$20 per class 10-2:00

*Buttons- individual or sets of 3-5 matching *Laces or trims *Ribbons






Cat's Cradle Creative Grids-Saturday, Feb 16

Turn your strips and strings of fabric into scrappy quilts! We'll sew samples of 2 different styles of string pieced quilts over base fabrics and paper.




Materials- *Lots of strips and strings in a variety of widths. *6 ½" muslin squares (about 20)






Square on Square Creative Grids- Saturday May 17

A fun way to use up smaller scraps! Frame up focus fabrics, then surround them with color.


Stockings- Friday, June 7 \$20 per class 10-2:00
