Sergeant, Massachusetts Line

Isaac Fuller one of the original Minutemen he answered the alarm of April 19, 1775 and marched to Marshfield, MA. where he served for 12 days. He enlisted in the Army at the end April 1775 for eight months as a sergeant in Capt. John Brigham's Company, Col. Theophilus Cotton's regiment in the Massachusetts Line.

At the end of the eight months, he reenlisted for a term of one year again as a sergeant in Capt. Samuel Bradford's company, Col. John Bailey's regiment, Gen. William Heaths Brigade in the Massachusetts line.

Isaac Fuller received a pension for his service.
