

### Super Bowl Thoughts and Season Recap

The Super Bowl year in and year out is the most watched, hyped, analyzed, scrutinized and wagered event in the world. It's the game where gambling goes from being a sort of "taboo" among the general public to something tens of millions will partake in.

Because everyone wants to have a little "extra" something on the big game whether it be Super Bowl squares, side or total or the more than 500 Super Bowl prop plays, demand is at an all-time high for handicappers to deliver their customers winners on the big game. Fair or unfair it's also the game customers usually judge whether or not to sign back up with a particular service for the next season.

As for us, we think betting the Super Bowl side and/or total is mainly a "sucker's bet" as there is so much more value on a weekly basis during the regular season when there is 60+ games to choose from in college and the NFL combined. If you disagree with us and think there is a lot of value on the Super Bowl, look no further than the graph on the bottom right of this page. The Vegas books have shown a profit in 29 of the last 31 Super Bowls (94%).

We don't know about you, but we don't like losing and going up against a 94% profitable system is something we're not going to step in front of and it's why we don't usually have our biggest play of the year on the Super Bowl side or total unlike many public bettors who tend to save their biggest bet of the year on the biggest game.

#### We feel there is much more value in the props market in the Super Bowl and that's why we give out 10 prop bets or so every vear to VIP customers. While we lean with the Rams -200 on the money-line, our favorite bet for this year's Super Bowl is to take the second half to out-score the first (good up to -150).

Win or lose, we would rather you judge us on the entire season where the star-rated picks on these pages (including bowls and playoffs) have gone 91-86-4 (not a good season). Add in the last six years and you're 613-513-23 (54%) betting every single star-rated pick on these pages the last 7 years. In an industry where so many touts advertise guaranteed winners and 70-90% records, the reality is 54% is the best record by far out of any newsletter the last 7 years (see page 4) and the most successful bettors (ex: Billy Walters) of all time have hit only 57% over the long haul.

Obviously we couldn't have had a successful last seven years without your support and patronage. Again, we can't thank you enough that you took a chance on us this season and for that we'll be forever grateful.

### Super Bowl Betting Notes (Reported By ESPN)

-Last year, \$136.1 million was bet on the Super Bowl at Nevada sports books. It the lowest handle for the state in 5 years with COVID impacting travel to the city.

The books have posted a profit in 29 of the past 31 Super Bowls (see below).

Since Nevada Gaming Control began tracking betting action on the Super Bowl in 1991, the books are up \$217.8 million. Their only losses came in 2008, when the New York Giants upset the Patriots, and in 1995, when the San Francisco 49ers routed the San Diego Chargers (see chart below).

According to an estimate released by the American Gaming Association, 31.4 mil-Ion Americans are expected to bet a total of \$7.61 billion on Super Bowl 56. The 31.4 million projected bettors would be a 35% increase from Super Bowl bettors in 2021, and the \$7.61 billion wagered would be a \$3.3 billion increase from the 2021 Super Bowl handle. This large increase can likely be attributed to the 45 million more Americans who can legally wager on this year's game in their home tota compared to 2021. state compared to 2021.

The early action on the Super Bowl has not seen much movement on side or total since last week. Sharper betters did bet the Rams and UNDER the first couple of days (opened LAR -3.5 and the total was 51).
