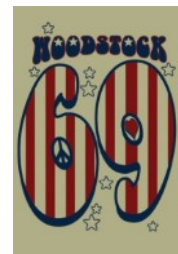

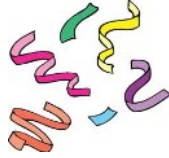

TIPS FOR GREENER BOAT CLEANING

Many cleaning products are harmful to aquatic life and some create imbalances that can lead to harmful algal blooms. Your choice of cleaning product for your boat is important – whether you clean your boat on land or on the water.

Boat U.S. Foundation tested 20 different ‘green’ boat soaps to see if they lived up to the product’s environmental claims. Based on their research and weighing all the factors (cleaning, performance, toxicity, and biodegradability), [Sailors for the Sea](#) came up with this list of top products:

1. Thetford Marine Boat Wash
2. Concrobium XT Eco-Wash
3. Mequiar’s Mirror Glaze Boat Gel Wash
4. Shurhold’s Yacht Brite Wash

The cost is around \$10 to \$20 for a quart for most of these products.

You can also use the same environmentally friendly products that you use around your house. Some companies that produce eco-friendly products are:

- Bon Ami
- Seventh Generation

Or you can make your own cleaning products:

- For bleach – use hydrogen peroxide
- For scouring – use baking soda
- For floor cleaners – use 1 cup vinegar in 2 gallons of water
- For window cleaners – use 1 capful white vinegar in 1 quart warm water
- For fiberglass stain remover – make a baking soda paste
- For mildew remover – make a paste of equal parts lemon juice and salt; or vinegar and salt

Remember cleaning products should never be washed into the lake, river, or stream!
