Western Washington Quilt Shop Hop 2018



Quilt blocks from the following shops are shown on the poster, reading left to right, top to bottom:

1st row: Sister's Quilt Shop; The Country Mouse; The Quiltmaker's Shoppe; Ben Franklin Crafts & Frame – Monroe; Aunt Mary's Quilt Shop.
2nd row: Running Stitch Fabrics; Pacific Fabrics – Bellevue; Calico Country; Shibori Dragon; Just for Fun! Quilting.
3rd row: Gathering Fabric Quilt Shop; Pacific Fabrics – Northgate; Carriage Country Quilts; Ben Franklin Crafts – Bonney Lake; Artco Crafts & Frames.
4th row: Pacific Fabrics – Bremerton; Fiddlesticks Quilt Shop; Longview Sewing & Kitchen; Tangled Threads Quilt Shop; The Quilt Barn.

7th row: The Quilt Nest & Yarn Boutique; Folktales; Pacific Fabrics – Sodo; Paisley Duck; Keepsake Cottage Fabrics.

Clothworks

Instructions for finishing the Shop Hop 2018 Quilt (as shown on poster).

35 Shop Hop blocks are used in this quilt.

Finished quilt size: 61½" x 80½" • Finished block size: 8" x 8"

Materials

(Yardages are based on 40" usable fabric width, after prewashing fabric and trimming selvages.)

1½ yds. Shop Hop 2018 royal blue clouds for sashing rectangles

½ yd. Shop Hop 2018 blue dots for cornerstones
½ yds. Shop Hop 2018 umbrellas for border
¾ yd. for binding (The Shop Hop 2018 umbrellas was used for the poster quilt.)
5½ yds. for backing (vertical seam)

Cutting

From Shop Hop royal blue clouds, cut:

 21 strips, 2" x 40"; crosscut 82 rectangles, 2" x 8½", for sashing rectangles

From Shop Hop blue dots, cut:

 3 strips, 2" x 40"; crosscut 48 squares, 2" x 2", for cornerstones

From Shop Hop umbrellas, cut:


• 4 strips, 6½" x length of fabric, for borders (These are cut long, and will be trimmed to size later.)

From binding fabric, cut:

• 8 strips, 2½" x 40", for double-fold binding

Quilt Top Assembly

- 1. Sew sashing rectangles and cornerstones, and sashing rectangles and Shop Hop blocks, together in horizontal rows as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram; then join horizontal rows together. Press all seams toward sashing rectangles.
- 2. Measure length of quilt top through center. Trim 2 border strips to this measurement, and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward border strips.
- 3. Measure width of quilt top, including borders just added, through center. Trim the remaining 2 border strips to this measurement and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward borders.

Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.

This year eight coordinating prints were designed especially for the Western Washington Quilt Shop Hop. The Shop Hop 2018 umbrellas print was designed by In The Beginning Fabrics. In The Beginning Fabrics also designed the Shop Hop 2018 blue rain drops print. The Shop Hop 2018 royal blue clouds and blue dots, as well as four other matching prints, were all designed by Clothworks.
