

## **2019 Bosque Farms Rodeo Queen Contest Expectation Agreement**

As a contestant in the Miss Bosque Farms Rodeo Queen pageant, I understand that should I win the title of Miss Bosque Farm Rodeo Queen/Princess/Sweetheart, I will be the official Bosque Farms Rodeo Association ambassador and will represent not only the association but also the community and the sport of rodeo.

I will strive to represent exceptional sportsmanship, high moral and ethical character and humane treatment of animals. I understand that this position is a privilege that can be taken away based on my actions.

I understand that this competition recognizes a number of attributes: sportsmanship, horsemanship, personality, public speaking, and appearance. Therefore, it is my responsibility as an official representative for my division to act, speak and dress according to the esteem my title deserves at any time that I may be in the public eye.

I understand that horsemanship skills are key to the promotion of the sport of rodeo as I may be invited to ride in parades and rodeos. Therefore, I will work to improve my riding ability and equine knowledge not only before the pageant but throughout the year if I win.

If I become a Bosque Farms Rodeo Queen/Princess/Sweetheart I agree to the following:

To always wear my crown, sash, and buckle along with appropriate western clothing including a cowboy hat and cowboy boots when making an appearance for BFRA.

To always look clean and neat when possible, without dark or distracting nail polish, unnatural hair color or visible tattoos.

To be available when asked to make scheduled appearances and be prepared for photographs, interviews, and interacting in a friendly manner with the public at these appearances.

To submit this agreement with my entry form and to agree that this will be part of a contractual agreement between the BFRA and me.

To uphold my title, encourage others to participate in future pageants and to assist in the promotion and production of the following year's pageant in every way.

To attend specific rodeos and official appearances as approved by the Queen Coordinator Joyce Battaglia and I agree to maintain close contact with said Queen Coordinator.

That as an elected title holder I will be required to sign a contract that will further explain my requirements and expectations throughout my reign.

That during the term from my entry as a contestant and throughout my reign, I will remain unmarried and childless and shall observe high standards of moral and ethical behavior befitting my title, thus setting a good example to the public, to future competitors and rodeo fans.

That I will not receive a salary or any sort of compensation as a rodeo queen contestant or title holder.

Also, I herewith release the sponsors, volunteers and the BFRA Pageant Committee from any claim for damage or liability as a result of accident or injury which may occur from my participation in any pageant event or event required in the BFRA activities.

I have read this Expectation Agreement and fully understand and agree to abide by the terms and to assume all liability and responsibility for loss, accident and/or injury, whether to my property or person, arising from the operation or activities of the BFRA committee or management, in any events while in or about the premises of the arena or location of pageant events.
