Annual Report of our 2014-2015 Season

Our mission statement reads:

The mission of the East Texas Youth Orchestra Inc. (herein known as ETYO) is to provide young East Texas musicians with high-quality orchestral instruction and significant opportunities for orchestral performance.

It has been a pivotal year for ETYO. With a new music director and conductor of our flagship group, the organization has experienced significant growth. With 62 musicians in our previous season, ETYO has grown to 97 musicians in its three orchestras in the 2014-2015 season. These orchestras enjoyed involvement in the following activities this season:

- Four Classical Concerts performed at various venues, free to the public.
- Side-by-side participation with the East Texas Symphony Orchestra in rehearsals and Symphony performance at University of Texas at Tyler's Cowan Center.
- Book Fair fundraising and ensemble performing at Barnes and Nobles Bookstore in Tyler.
- Noted Circle Concert honoring long-time conductors and avid supporters: Joanie Russell and Archie Jones.
- Auditions were held at area high schools.
- Five of our musicians were awarded the Women's Symphony League of Tyler's Alex Fleming Memorial Music Scholarships.

Additionally, new board officers and members were added, and discussions are ongoing concerning the employment of an executive director.

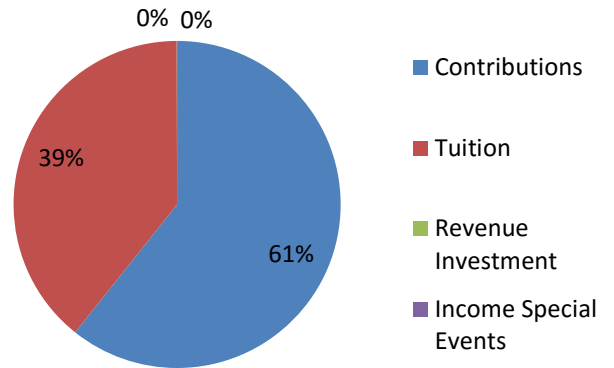

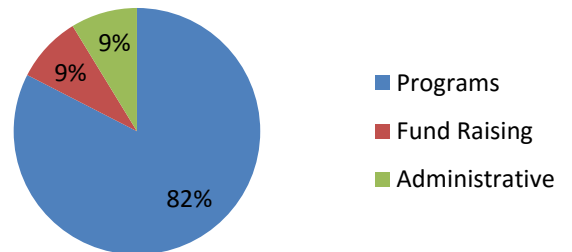
**East Texas Youth Orchestra
