OCNA SEASIDE CHARACTER GUIDELINES:

OCNA is leading a group of neighbors to discuss and refine the creation of a proposed "Seaside overlay" ordinance that would be used by City Planners to help preserve some of the unique characteristics of our Seaside neighborhood.

So far, the group has met 4 times and refined the following:

1) Modified the original proposed overlay boundaries to Missouri St north, Horne and Clementine east, Oceanside Blvd south, and the East side of Freeman west.

2) Supported the City Ordinance that 2 trees should be planted in the parkway based on the City's guidelines

3) That inclusion of any Additional Dwelling Units (ADU's) will be positioned in the rear of the property along with the current setbacks and other restrictions already defined.

4) Rooflines may not exceed 16ft in the front and 27ft in the rear of the property to manage building bulk and mass.

5) Continuing to discuss a proposal to prohibit second story roof top decks which effectively "live" like a third story.

Please join us on **Tuesday, Nov 13**th (one week earlier than normal) to hear why this idea is being pursued, the latest discussions on this topic and to answer questions.

Oceanside TIDES, the Vine Street Townhomes are well under way as construction about 50% complete and retaining walls and landscaping going in as we speak. The 58 units have sizes ranging from 1219 to 1814 sq feet and are completely solar powered.



The project owner, City Ventures is working to have models for viewing January 2019. Prices range from \$549,990's to \$649,990.
