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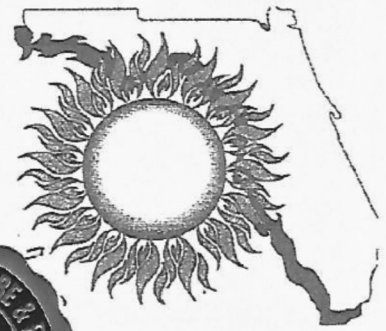

Your Hospitality Committee

The Hernando County Planning & Zoning (P&Z) Commission acts as an advisory body to the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) on matters pertaining to rezoning and other land use issues in Hernando County, Florida. All functions are performed in a Quasi-Judicial forum. The Commission consists of seven members. Five members are appointed at the discretion of each County Commissioner, and two alternate members are appointed by the Board of County Commissioners as a whole. They meet in Brooksville the first Monday of each month in the BOCC Chambers.

The P&Z has delegated decision authority for Conditional Use Permits and Special Exceptions. Conditional Use Permits are usually two years for temporary structures and five years for excavations. They are usually

granted in rural areas for hardships. Specially Exceptions are granted with the property and not the owner. The P&Z can issue both. They are effective 30 days after issuing. The BOCC can review the P&Z decision. If not approved by the BOCC, the applicant can file a civil objection in the circuit court. Decision making is evidence based. Statements must be included in the application packet in order to be considered. Additionally, only in-person testimony is considered. All deliberations are subject to the Florida "Sunshine Law Legislation". As it relates to Public Inquiry Workshops (PIW), the requirements are determined by the nature of the application. Not every application warrants a PIW. They usually add 30 days to 60 processing cycle. The County P&Z Staff, P&Z Commission and other agencies can request a PIW based upon the intensity of the impact. The purpose of the PIW is to identify up-front issues prior to the P&Z Commission hearings.

John Allocco stated residents often ask "How can we get our message to the BOCC?" He stated residents should feel free to reach out and call BOCC members. For items on the BOCC agenda, residents must show up personally. Quasi-judicial cases usually involve changing zoning. The BOCC is not able to use emails, phone calls, etc. by law. Commissioner Allocco spoke about how challenging COVID has been for everyone including local government. Public record is open and transparent in Florida.

David Skinner introduced April Johnson from LifeSouth for a HBPOA Blood Drive on Saturday, February 6, 2021 at the Fire Department from 11 am-5 pm. Giving blood takes about 35 minutes. LifeSouth has the red, white and blue buses and have been here for 30 years. Main office on State Road 50. The blood supply is low nationally. A therapy is convalescent plasma making antibodies which LifeSouth is also seeking. You can give blood every 56 days. If you give platelets, every 2 weeks, plasma, every 4 weeks. About 70% of the population are eligible to give, but on-

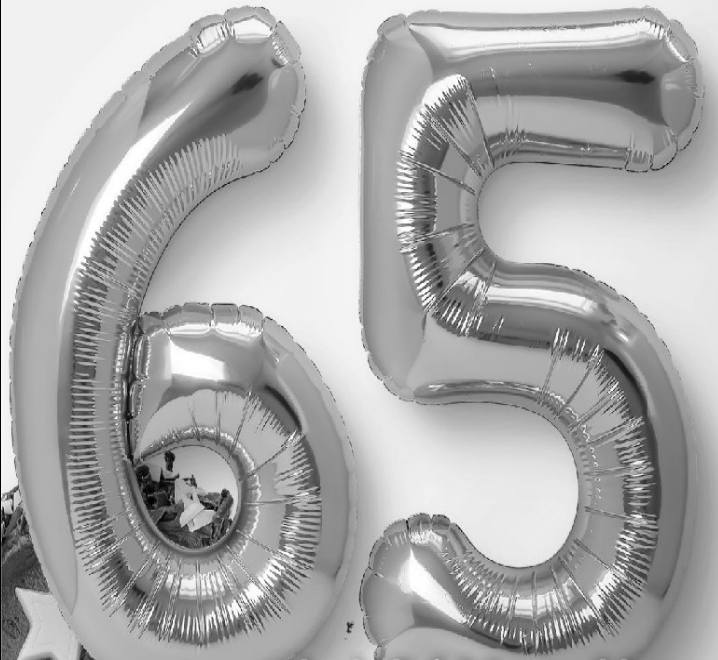

Treasurer's Report - Read audit letter from the Jaspers stating Sarah Hill did an impeccable job and the only concern is the utility bills for the Triangle and Dolphin areas. Beginning balance in January 2021 was \$22,381.95 and ending balance is \$18,440.47. Diane asked Sarah Hill to come forward and receive a Certificate of Appreciation as she resigned.

Hospitality report - Welcome New Members, Mr. & Mrs. Alan Green. Heart month. 50/50 raffle.

Landscape committee- Working on the costs for electric and water.

Beachcomber - February 10 deadline. Pictures and stories are wanted. We encourage members to write articles about the area history, waters, fishing, development, retirement, family life on the beach or any other topic that would be interesting to the community.

Government Affairs Committee (GAC) - HB Marina had applied for rezoning. The membership supported this at the January meeting. BOCC agreed 4-1. HB Marina rezoning approved.

Environmental committee - Eight people have expressed interest. We need a chairperson. Diane suggested if you see another group cleaning up the area feel free to volunteer your time.

Coastal Hernando Business Group – They are planning a Beach Bash for Memorial Day weekend and Labor Day weekend. Scott Herring spoke to them about crosswalks, speed, etc. that Hernando County was completing a traffic study on Shoal Line.

Denis Polyn is going to resign from the bylaws committee since Brian Hawkins volunteered to

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make up the bylaws committee of three. Mike Fulford motioned to accept. Seconded Erin Daly. **Motion approved.**

Barry Holland, Chair of the By-Laws Committee has drafted by-laws. (Dave Sarkis, Brian Hawkins committee members). HBPOA members are to review and make any suggestions, comments to any board member within the next week. The By-Laws will be brought up at the March meeting for a vote.

Denis Polyn asked the membership what Option they would like for Membership - Option 1, 2, 3. Also, look at property addendum, which goes further south to Osowaw. Board voted to recommend Option 1 and the Alternate A map. A member proposed that membership fee be different for single person or dual households. The Board will set the membership dues.

Adjourn for raffle. Jen Brown motioned to adjourn. Scott seconded. **Motion passed.** Diane asked non-voting members to leave to discuss litigation strategy.

The meeting was reconvened. Scott Fitzgerald stated that some individuals erroneously believe that membership in the HBPOA is for fourteen calendar months. It is not – it is expressly limited to twelve calendar months, the period from January 1 to December 31. To eliminate any possible confusion, the Board would like the membership

to interpret Article II, subsections 4, 5 and 6, of the Bylaws in harmony to mean, as expressly stated in Article 4, that "The fiscal year for membership is from January 1 through December 31."

Jen Brown made the motion, I move that the ambiguous phrase "membership standing and roster", found in subsection 6 of Article II of the HBPOA Bylaws, be interpreted to mean that when a membership expires at the end of a fiscal year the former member can receive two free copies of the Beachcomber in January and February of the following year. The phrase in question, based on the intent of the members when it was drafted, relates to a former member receiving two free copies of the Beachcomber in January and February of the following year in the hopes that they might subsequently apply for a new membership. It does not mean that a membership runs from January 1 to February 28 of the following year, which is clearly inconsistent with subsection 4, which states "The fiscal year for membership is from January 1 to December 31. Judy Zellmer seconded. Discussion. Director Fran Baird has not paid dues for 2021. Fran stated that she plans to resign this evening. The Board gave Fran a Certificate of Appreciation presented by Diane. Chuck Greenwell motioned to table the ambiguity in by-laws. Erin seconded to table. **Motion approved.**

Bill Roberts made a motion to move forward on litigation. Bill stated, "The purpose of the Hernando Beach Property Owners Association is to

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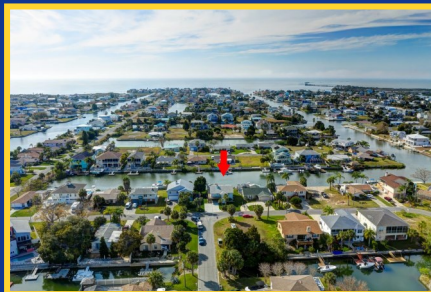

unite the property owners of Hernando Beach for civic purposes that lead to improved quality of life. I move, in the interest of a community that is free of bullying and that works together for the greater good, that the Hernando Beach Property Owners Association (HBPOA) authorize the HBPOA Board to take whatever actions are reasonably necessary to litigate the pending action against the HBPOA in the best interest of the HBPOA and to continue to do so to the point of funds available after 2021 HBPOA operating expenses are removed." Mike Fulford seconded. Discussion. The amended request for documents from Jodie Pillarella and Kelly Reeve again asked for personal information. Jodie Pillarella has not paid dues for 2021. Insurance is not an option for the HBPOA to consider due to alleged HBPOA's GAC actions against S&T fishing business resulting in a cease and desist letter and threat of litigation against the HBPOA. Mike Fulford called question on Bill Robert's motion to move forward on litigation. **Motion passed.**

## RECREATIONAL LICENSES

Pursuant to Florida Statute 379.354, the following individuals are **EXEMPT** from recreational hunting, freshwater fishing or saltwater fishing licenses as well as Florida waterfowl, migratory bird, deer, turkey, snook, spiny lobster, archery, crossbow, muzzleloading and management area permit requirements (unless noted, these exemptions do not apply to federal duck stamp requirements):

- Youth under 16 years of age (also exempt from federal duck stamp requirements).
- Resident seniors age 65 or older with proof of age or [residency](#) (such as a valid Florida Driver's License or ID Card) or possessing an optional Resident 65+ Hunt/Fish Certificate (available at

no-cost online at [GoOutdoorsFlorida.com](http://GoOutdoorsFlorida.com) or at county tax collectors' offices)

- Those freshwater fishing or hunting in your county of residence on your homestead (or the homestead of your spouse or minor child), or if you are a minor child freshwater fishing or hunting on the homestead of your parent.
- Florida residents certified as totally and permanently disabled who possess a Florida Resident Disabled Person's Hunting and Fishing License.
- Florida residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States, who are not stationed in this state and home on leave for 30 days or less, upon submission of orders.
- Those hunting for wild hog on private land.
- Individuals who are observing or filming someone else who is fishing or hunting and who are not assisting (baiting hooks, reeling, setting decoys, calling birds, etc.) in the take in any way.

- Disabled veterans or active or reserve duty military service members and their immediate family members and assistants, who are participating in a permitted outdoor recreational event, for which the Commission has issued a Military/Disabled Veteran Event License Exemption Permit to the event organizer.

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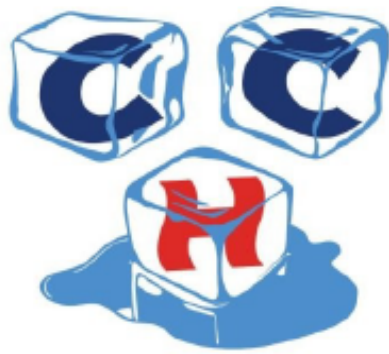

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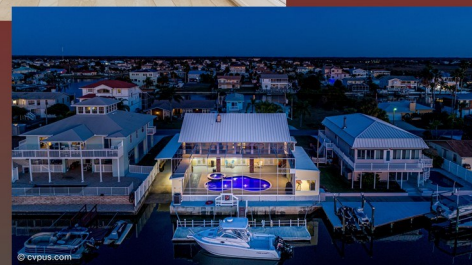
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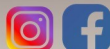
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
